☐ Remove smudges and marks from walls and partitions		
☐ Restock paper products, hand sanitizer (if applicable), and hand soap		
☐ Sweep and mop floors using disinfectant		
☐ Dust/clean doors, mirrors, partitions, vents, baseboards		
☐ Remove cobwebs from all areas

Post Cleaning Goals Restrooms should feel sanitary and fresh-smelling. Fixtures and mirrors should be streak-free, floors should be dry and clean, and supplies must be fully stocked.		
BREAK ROOM		
Frequency: 2x/Month		
 Sweep and mop floors with sanitizing agent Empty all trash cans and replace liners Disinfect high-touch surfaces: door handles, switches, partitions Clean and disinfect outside of refrigerator Dust all surfaces Wipe down and disinfect chairs and tables Clean and sanitize sinks Restock all paper products, hand sanitizers (if applicable), and soap Dust baseboards and vents Remove cobwebs from all areas Clean windowsills

Post Cleaning Goals Break room should be tidy, free of odors, and hygienic. Surfaces should be disinfected, floors clean and dry, and trash properly managed. High-touch areas must feel safe and clean.

Strip & Wax of vinyl floors
Buff and re-coat of vinyl floors
