CleanSlate Janitorial Scope of Work

This Scope of Work outlines the janitorial cleaning standards for CleanSlate Outpatient Addiction Medicine, an outpatient rehabilitation and MAT (Medication-Assisted Treatment) facility.

The purpose of this guide is to provide clear direction to janitorial staff on maintaining a visibly clean, safe, and welcoming environment for patients, visitors, and staff.

Each cleaning technician must:

- Follow task instructions by area and frequency (Daily, Weekly, Monthly).
- Use appropriate cleaning supplies, PPE, and disinfectants rated for healthcare environments.
- Focus on visible cleanliness, infection prevention, and odor control.
- Prioritize patient experience, ensuring that every space feels sanitary, calm, and professional.

1. Lobby / Reception Area

Daily Tasks

- Empty all trash and replace liners; wipe inside/outside of cans as needed.
- Clean and disinfect all door handles, push plates, and entry glass (inside/outside).
- Dust and damp mop hard flooring with neutral disinfectant cleaner.
- Vacuum entry mats and waiting area carpets.
- Wipe and disinfect counters, reception desks, tables, and seating arms.
- Disinfect high-touch items (pens, clipboards, kiosks, etc.).

Weekly Tasks

- Dust window sills, blinds, and display surfaces.
- Wipe down baseboards and remove scuff marks.
- Spot clean interior walls and door frames.

Monthly Tasks

Dust light fixtures and air vents within reach.

Equipment & Supplies Needed

Glass cleaner, microfiber cloths, vacuum, mop & bucket, neutral disinfectant, gloves.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Lobby glass is streak-free and spotless.
- Counters and seating visibly clean and sanitized.
- Floors dry, streak-free, and odor-free.
- Space feels fresh and professional upon entry.

2. Patient Exam Rooms

Daily Tasks

- Empty trash and replace liners.
- Wipe and disinfect exam tables, counters, chairs, and sinks (use healthcare-grade disinfectant).
- Clean and disinfect all touchpoints: light switches, handles, keyboards, phones, etc.
- Spot mop and disinfect floors.

Weekly Tasks

- Dust ledges, medical cart surfaces, and under counter areas.
- Spot clean walls and door frames.

Monthly Tasks

Dust vents, high surfaces, and overhead lights.

Equipment & Supplies Needed

• Hospital-grade disinfectant, microfiber cloths, mop system, gloves/PPE.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Surfaces sanitized and residue-free.
- Floors and counters visibly clean.
- No odor, stains, or buildup anywhere.

3. Nursing Stations & Medical Offices

Daily Tasks

- Empty trash and replace liners.
- Wipe and disinfect desks, countertops, and shared workstations.

- Sanitize phones, keyboards, and drawer handles.
- Dust and damp mop or vacuum floors.

Weekly Tasks

- Dust window sills, shelves, and monitors (use screen-safe wipes).
- Spot clean walls and cabinetry.

Monthly Tasks

• Dust vents, blinds, and high surfaces.

Equipment & Supplies Needed

• Disinfectant spray, microfiber cloths, computer-safe wipes, vacuum, mop & bucket.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Work surfaces and electronics sanitized.
- Floors free of debris and streaks.
- Area appears organized and hygienic.

4. Restrooms

Daily Tasks

- Clean and disinfect sinks, toilets, urinals, mirrors, and dispensers.
- Refill soap, towel, and tissue supplies from client stock.
- Mop and disinfect all floors with approved restroom disinfectant.
- Clean and polish fixtures, handles, and partitions.
- Empty and disinfect trash cans.

Weekly Tasks

- Scrub walls, doors, and stall partitions below 5 ft.
- Pour water into floor drains to maintain traps.

Monthly Tasks

Clean vents, ceiling corners, and light fixtures.

Equipment & Supplies Needed

• Restroom disinfectant, bowl cleaner, mop & bucket, gloves, microfiber cloths.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Fixtures sparkle, odor-free.
- Floors dry and sanitary.
- Dispensers stocked and surfaces spotless.

5. Breakroom / Staff Kitchen

Daily Tasks

- Empty trash, replace liners, and wipe bin exteriors.
- Clean and disinfect sinks, countertops, tables, and appliance exteriors.
- Wipe inside/outside of microwave.
- Clean coffee station and refrigerator exterior.
- Mop floor with neutral disinfectant cleaner.

Weekly Tasks

- Dust cabinet tops, vents, and backsplash areas.
- Spot clean walls and light switches.

Monthly Tasks

• Wipe refrigerator interior (coordinate with staff to clear contents).

Equipment & Supplies Needed

Food-safe disinfectant, microfiber cloths, mop, gloves.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Food-prep areas sanitized and odor-free.
- Floors clean, non-sticky, and streak-free.
- Appliances wiped and shiny.

6. Hallways & Common Areas

Daily Tasks

- Vacuum or dust mop and disinfect all floors.
- Empty trash bins and wipe exteriors.
- Clean high-touch points (door handles, push plates, light switches).
- Spot clean walls and glass panels.

Weekly Tasks

- Dust baseboards, vents, and door frames.
- Remove cobwebs from corners and ceilings.

Monthly Tasks

Clean light fixtures and return air vents.

Equipment & Supplies Needed

Mop & bucket, disinfectant, microfiber cloths, duster, vacuum.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Corridors neat and bright.
- Floors streak-free, no debris.
- No visible dust or cobwebs.

7. Counseling / Group Rooms

Daily Tasks

- Empty trash and replace liners.
- Vacuum carpets or damp mop hard flooring.
- Disinfect tables, chairs, and touchpoints.

Weekly Tasks

- Dust furniture, picture frames, and window sills.
- Spot clean walls and door frames.

Monthly Tasks

Dust vents, blinds, and light fixtures.

Equipment & Supplies Needed

Disinfectant cleaner, microfiber cloths, vacuum, mop & bucket.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Room tidy, organized, and odor-free.
- All seating and tables visibly clean and disinfected.

8. Trash & Biohazard Handling

Daily Tasks

- Remove all general waste and recycling from facility.
- Transport to designated dumpster or pickup area.
- Handle any medical sharps containers or red bags only if sealed by staff (do not open or move unsealed items).
- · Wipe trash bin exteriors as needed.

Monthly Tasks

• Deep clean all trash receptacles (inside/outside).

Equipment & Supplies Needed

Trash liners (various sizes), gloves/PPE, disinfectant wipes.

Post Cleaning Goals

- No overflowing or dirty bins.
- Receptacles clean, odor-free, and properly lined.

9. Floors (All Types)

Daily Tasks

- Vacuum carpeted areas and mats.
- Sweep and mop hard floors using appropriate neutral cleaner.
- Spot clean spills immediately.

Weekly Tasks

Edge vacuum carpet perimeters and corners.

Monthly Tasks

Dust baseboards and deep clean grout (as needed).

Equipment & Supplies Needed

• Vacuum, mop & bucket, floor cleaner, microfiber dust mop.

Post Cleaning Goals

- Floors free of debris and streaks.
- Uniform appearance throughout facility.

General Equipment & Supplies Checklist

- Microfiber cloths (color-coded for restrooms, patient areas, general areas)
- Mop & bucket with wringer
- Neutral disinfectant and restroom disinfectant
- Glass cleaner
- PPE (gloves, masks optional)
- Trash liners (various sizes)
- Dusters and extension poles
- Floor signage ("Wet Floor")

Post Cleaning Goals Summary

- Visible Cleanliness: All areas appear neat, orderly, and debris-free.
- Disinfection: High-touch areas sanitized using medical-grade disinfectant.
- Odor Control: No lingering odors fresh, neutral scent throughout.
- Safety: Proper use of PPE and caution signage.
- Customer Experience: Clinic presents a calm, professional, and hygienic environment for every patient.
