As the Day Porter, you're the backbone of this site's cleanliness during business hours. Your attention to detail sets the tone for everyone walking through the door. From keeping high-traffic zones spotless to ensuring break rooms stay stocked and restrooms stay fresh, your role keeps things running smoothly. The work may be behind the scenes—but the results are front and center. Stay focused, stay efficient, and let pride in your craft speak through every clean surface.

1. Decompression Areas

Daily Tasks (Monday–Friday)
☐ Empty and clean trash receptacles; replace liners as needed.
☐ Spot clean glass and walls.
☐ Damp mop non-carpeted flooring.
☐ Clean and disinfect sinks and fixtures.
☐ Refill all paper towel, soap, and sanitizer dispensers.
Weekly Tasks
☐ Dust ledges and tops of fixtures (rotated throughout the week).
Monthly Tasks
☐ Wash partitions, doors, tile walls, grills, and enamel surfaces in nearby restrooms

Basic Equipment & Supplies Needed

☐ Dust all restroom light fixtures.

☐ Machine scrub restroom floors with germicidal detergent.

Surfaces, especially sinks and fixtures, are visibly disinfected and polished. 2. Common Areas (including hallways and lobbies) **Daily Tasks** Spot clean glass doors and wall marks. Maintain floor appearance in high-traffic zones (spot mop as needed). ■ Monitor for spills or debris throughout the shift. ☐ Prepare areas for evening vacuuming/mopping (remove obstructions, straighten mats/furniture). **Weekly Tasks** Dust tops of fixtures and ledges (rotate through zones across the week). **Monthly Tasks** ☐ Wash partitions, doors, tile walls, grills, and enamel surfaces in nearby restrooms. Dust all restroom light fixtures.

4. Restrooms (Daytime Maintenance)

☐ Machine scrub flooring with germicidal detergent.
(Daily and weekly restroom cleaning handled by evening team; porter only completes monthly detail tasks.)

- Step ladder (for fixtures)

Post Cleaning Goals

- Restrooms remain sanitized at deep-clean level monthly.
- Light fixtures free from cobwebs and dust.
- Grime buildup and stains addressed thoroughly to support daily clean retention.

General Day Porter Reminders

- Always communicate with building management by 2:30 PM to address any specific site requests.
- Use downtime between tasks for proactive spot cleaning or early prep.
- Leave all areas ready for evening cleaning crew (no chairs or bins in the way, spills addressed, floors dry or drying).
