Introduction

This scope of work provides a structured cleaning program for Resonetics facilities. It is designed as a technician-friendly guide for janitorial teams.

- Follow the detailed tasks by area and frequency.
- Ensure use of correct supplies and equipment for each surface.
- Cleaning must result in visible cleanliness, streak-free finishes, and sanitized high-touch points.
- The goal is to maintain a safe, hygienic, and professional workplace environment that supports employee health and customer confidence.

1. Restrooms

Daily Tasks

- Spot clean and restock all restrooms.
- Thoroughly sanitize all fixtures, sinks, toilets, urinals, and flat surfaces.
- Sweep, dry mop, and wet mop floors using disinfectant.
- Clean and polish mirrors, chrome, and flush valves.

Weekly Tasks

- Clean and disinfect stall partitions.
- Pour 1 gallon of water into visible floor drains to prevent odor.

Monthly Tasks

- Wipe down and disinfect walls.
- Clean and disinfect grout.

Annual Tasks

Deep clean entrance and restroom windows inside and out.

- Thoroughly clean the Mother's Room (if applicable).

Weekly Tasks

Detail clean appliance exteriors and high-touch points.

- Glass cleaner, stainless steel polish
