

CABERNET SAUVIGNON – PETIT VERDOT

Trait d'Union 2025



As a continuation of our collection dedicated to single-varietal wines, **Trait d'Union** marks our first encounter between two grape varieties: **50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 50% Petit Verdot**. Grown on plots planted in **2021** on the Bernon and Ridet terroirs in Lugon, they have been brought together to express their complementary qualities: the structure and elegance of Cabernet Sauvignon combined with the intensity and character of Petit Verdot.

In Bordeaux, the **2025 vintage** stood out for its early ripening and favourable conditions, which allowed the grapes to reach excellent maturity. The harvest preserved a fine balance between concentration, freshness and aromatic expression, giving rise to a wine with an assertive yet refined character.

Trait d'Union 2025 reveals an expressive bouquet of red and black fruits, complemented by delicate floral notes and subtle hints of spice. The palate is fruity, generous and well-balanced, supported by an elegant tannic structure and a fresh, lingering finish.
