MANDATORY: HELMENTS for Ski Racing are REQUIRED (NO SOFT EARS or GoPro Mounts Allowed)

- Heats will be determined by random draw, 4 racer format
- Clothing requirements must wear a loose 2 piece ski suit (NO downhill/speed suits); minimum measurement at thigh and upper arm should be 5 cm/2 inches of loose fabric
- RECOMMENDED: Spine Protection and Mouth Guards

- Class sizes and breakdowns may be adjusted based on registration numbers; classes may be merged within gender or age
- Racers will get a minimum of 30 minutes for inspection and minimum of 1 hour for training
- There are 2 full races – 1 race on Saturday and 1 race on Sunday
- Lane assignment will be determined by bib number
- LCQ to ensure that all racers get at least 2 runs.
- Medals will be awarded for top 3 finishers. Recognition will go to 8th to fourth place.
