EMERGENCY PROCEDURES



FIRE

In case of fire:

- 1. Remove persons from danger:
- Yourself
- Other tenants and visitors
- 2. Raise the Alarm:
- Call 000, ask for Fire Brigade
- Address: <u>74-76 Upper Pitt St</u>, Kirribilli
- Nearest cross St: Parkes St
- Knock on neighbours doors
- 3. Contain the fire:
- To the room or space of origin
- Close doors behind you
- 4. Extinguish or Evacuate the area:
- Exit via your closest exit
- Exit building at G or LG level
- Go to the assembly area <u>car park</u> on McBurney Lane
- Only attempt to extinguish fire if safe and you are trained

Important:

- 1. If you hear the alarms, evacuate
- 2. If you see smoke, don't panic
- 3. Do not re-enter the building
- 4. Leave personal items behind
- 5. Assist others to evacuate



DOMESTIC FIRE SAFETY

- Heaters Keep away from other things
- **2. Candles** stabalise if using. Torches are preferred
- 3. Clothes dryer change lint every time & never leave unattended
- **4. Dishwasher** never leave home with it running
- Fire extinguisher installed in common areas. It is worthwhile owning a small extinguisher.
- Fire blanket it is worthwhile owning your own fire blanket for the kitchen
- 7. Assembly area: car park on McBurney Lane

MEDICAL EMERGENCY


- 1. Remain calm & don't panic
- 2. Call 000, ask for Ambulance
- 3. If trained, commence 1st aid treatment
- 4. Otherwise provide reassurance
- 5. Do not move the person unless absolutely necessary
- 6. Direct ambulance to building entrance
