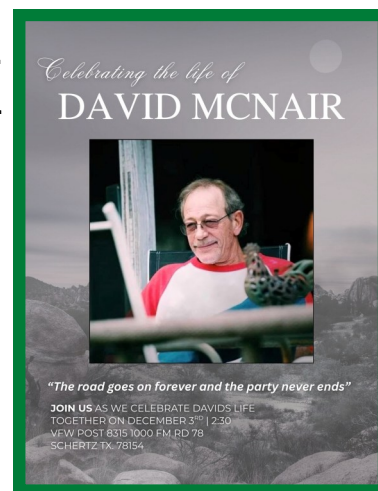


Feliz Navidad and Merry Christmas!

Praise God our visa was approved until April of 2027. In order to travel and return easily to Spain we needed our Spanish ID's (TIE). We were scheduled to pick them up on December 3 and 5th. Thankfully, we were able to go early and tell the National Police Station the circumstances. They were able to go in the back, dig out our cards, and give them to us early. It was such a relief. We had already booked our flights and were believing for things to come together. Because of God's favor, here we are.



Wayne has been using his musical abilities to write songs to help the kids at El Ancla learn their colors, greetings, numbers and fruit in English. We have 5 first graders and 9 second graders who attend. I do the planning and teaching and he does all the fun stuff. He greets the kids as Charlie a puppet and teaches them English greetings. We will miss a couple of weeks of classes but Jayme the director will take over for us. They are closed for the holidays from Dec. 18 to Jan. 8 so we won't miss much.

We have been praying about my hernia. When would be a good time to come to the states to have it done. David's memorial was a good reason to come home so I have an appointment to meet with a surgeon on December 15. Hopefully I can get it done and healed by the time we had planned to go back to Spain.

Sometimes it feels like things are moving slowly but things are moving. I know we are touching lives with the love of Jesus and helping to restore their lives and faith. As they tell me about my Spanish, poco a poco. Thank you for being apart of what we are doing. We always pray you find us faithful.

One thing I know for sure is I am thankful that God so loved the world (me and you) that He gave His one and only Son that we might not perish but have everlasting life. Christmas time is a time to remember that gift the God sent to us. We don't earn it we just have to receive it. I pray that all will receive the best Christmas gift ever, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
