Well, its been almost a year since we arrived here in Spain last April 25th. Here is a summary of some of what has been happening in here. We have learned a lot about Spanish culture and have been adjusting well. We still have a few challenges ahead but nothing, with the Lord's help, we can't overcome.

Wayne has been studying hard to get his Spanish drivers license. He had to learn all the rules and take a theory test which he passed. Now he has to drive with a driving school. For him the biggest challenge is to learn the Spanish terminology they will tell him on the driving test. He spends hours a day studying those terms.

We have submitted the documents to the immigration lawyer for our application for our extended visa. Hopefully they will approve it for the remaining 4 years. That is how long we feel like the Lord has asked us to commit to.

In the meantime, we continue to reach out to the community. Doing street evangelism with songs and testimonies. Pastor is amazed at the difference having the music makes. Before when they preached in the park, people would call and complain to the police. Thankfully we have had no issues. Except while in this slum area a man got a little angry and was shouting from a far. One man stopped and sang with us, others take videos or come and watch. Some asks questions and we are able to share Christ with them and a message of hope.



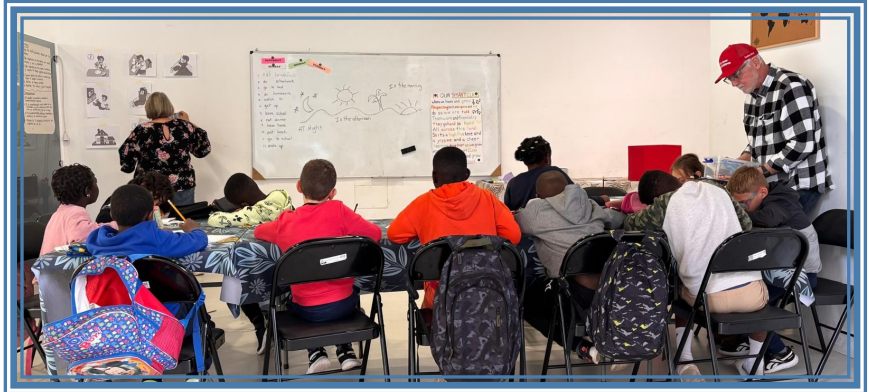
I (Sandy) am still volunteering at the coffee shop/clothing store on Fridays. There are a couple of ladies in particular that I have been building relationships with. They love when I can get a break and sit to chat with them. Little by little showing them the love of Christ and being able to speak into their lives. We find common things like our children and families to talk about. Sowing seeds along the way.

We are excited that we have been asked to go back to Zalla in April to help at the Albergue for the pilgrims walking the Camino de Santiago. We will cover for the missionaries who normally work there while they come to Roquetas for a ECM, European Christian Missions conference. It will give them opportunity to learn, relax and enjoy the presence of the Lord, and give us opportunity to minister.

On Mondays and Wednesdays from 10-11:30 I take Spanish classes with other immigrants. There are three ladies from Morocco and one young man from Senegal in the class. We all need to learn Spanish to be able to live and function here. We all are experiencing the same challenges. Plus Thursday I take an online class.

On Monday from 4-6 I help and teach English. The first class for 4-6 year olds, I help Jayme, she and her husband run El Ancla (the Anchor). The next hour I teach the 2nd and 3rd graders. They are a handful but we have fun and they are learning. Wayne plays music for them including a class song he has written for them. One of the children's moms who also is in my Spanish class said that her son enjoys our classes better than the ones in school and just wants to come there. That was a encouraging word.

Since our last newsletter we have seen many answered prayers. We have had new opportunities for ministry. The Bible study is going well. We have a new grandson, Micaiah Lior McNair born December 27th. He weighed 10lbs 8 oz, 21 inches long.
