Our Journey and Impact

SACHETA was conceived as the philanthropic arm of SHAPE, a boutique consulting firm specializing in holistic development. Founded by Prof. Muni Chakrabarti and Shri Tushar Bhattacharya, SHAPE's work in the Gosaba block of the Sunderbans highlighted the pressing needs of distressed and underserved populations, leading to the establishment of SACHETA. Over the past two decades, SACHETA has touched the lives of close to 10,000 beneficiaries through its various programs. In 2016, SACHETA established its own office and education centre in Amtali village. Today, with the support of local resident teachers, SACHETA operates multiple centres, extending its reach through collaborations with like-minded organizations beyond the Sunderbans.

- 1. Navadisha (Education): Providing supplementary education to children, ensuring they receive the necessary academic support to thrive.
- 2. Purbasha (Livelihood): Implementing livelihood programs that equip individuals with skills and opportunities to achieve economic independence.
- 3. Disha (Digital Skills): Offering computer literacy drives to bridge the digital divide and enhance employability.
- 4. Prantika (Plantation): Conducting plantation drives to promote environmental sustainability and community well-being.
- 5. Sushrusha (Health Support): Organizing health drives to provide essential medical services and promote wellness.
- 6. Praktoni (Mentorship): Establishing mentorship programs to guide and support individuals in their personal and professional development.
