LEFT, CENTER, RIGHT (LCR)

Every Thursday, the Lodge holds a gathering for the game of Left, Center, Right. Normally, two games are held each evening starting at 6:30 p.m. Each game costs each player \$3.00.

The game begins with each player rolling three dice. The dice have the following faces:

- R indicates a \$1.00 is passed to the player on the right.
- C indicates a \$1.00 is placed in the center pot.
- L indicates a \$1.00 is passed to the player on the left
- Dot indicates no action.

Based on the results of the dice roll, players pass their chips accordingly. For example, if a player rolls one L, one R, and one dot, they would pass \$1.00 to the left, \$1.00 to the right, and keep \$1.00 for themselves. If a player rolls three dots, they keep all their chips.

The game continues until only one player has dollars remaining. That player is declared the winner and collects all the dollars in the center pot.

At the total cost of only \$3.00 per game, LCR is a fun filled, extremely entertaining game for all participant. Remember that luck plays a significant role in the game, so enjoy the unpredictability.

LCR is a popular game for its simplicity and fast-paced nature. It's accessible to players of all ages and requires no special skill or strategy beyond luck and timing.
