## THE WANDERING ELKS



Greeting Delray Elks,

Well, we slowed our roll but are still in upstate NY as we head to my Hometown of Cortland (Home of 2024 NCAA Division 3 Football NATIONAL state school...CONGRATS!) We have been here a month and probably gonna be in Cortland for another month. But, before we got here, we stayed at Seneca Falls Elks Lodge #992. This lodge, since we visited last year, put in an electrical hookup for only one RV. No problem because we had a real quiet generator that can power the Airstream

for days. The Seneca Falls Lodge is located a mile or so outside of town in an expansive hunk of property and a big parking lot (which we had to ourselves). They are planning on adding more hookups we're told. It also has a big pavilion and lit bocce ball courts.

There is something to be said about going back to a lodge and having the bartenders, members and officials remember and embrace you. We got all sorts of info about the many wineries, breweries, creameries, and distilleries that are all alongside the five beautiful lakes along "THE FINGER LAKES WINE TRAIL". We went to many that were recommended by the members and each place was unique and cool. We enjoyed this location so much that we even volunteered to help in the kitchen (since we ALL have vast experience) for Sunday morning breakfast buffet. We originally intended to just help but soon took over and had it organized and knocked out in no time. They were very appreciative of our knowledge and ability and let us do our thing. We were very glad to help out and see it done right. Whenever I'm in Seneca Falls (the town I was actually born in), we will definitely stop to visit again and volunteer.

After a few days, we ventured down Seneca Lake to the cool little town of Watkins Glen. Watkins Glen is known for its famous racetrack and also its magnificent gorge trails located just up the hill from the town center. It's probably the most scenic stretch of trail...less than 2 miles long and packed with waterfalls, gorges and fantastic rock and river formations that we have encountered anywhere in the USA. Just a small lake town that has in its reach dozens of wineries (which we certainly checked out). It also boasts Elks Lodge #1546, a cool ass lodge perched on a hill overlooking the lake. Having a late afternoon drink on the deck with that view was awesome. All lodges we visited have their own unique history or architecture or, as in this case, location. It's a testament to the foresight the previous generations of Elks had to secure the land that their lodges were built. The amount of land acreage that Seneca Falls, Hattiesburg, Mississippi and Westminster (Denver), etc., that the Elks acquired back then, would be unaffordable nowadays. I've seen a lot of "in city" lodges eventually get squeezed out due to the economy, parking and diminished membership. I'd hate to see our lodge succumb to that fate. Let's make sure that doesn't happen!

Sadly, we had to bid farewell to our Traveling Elk mates, JL and Michele Snowden. They have to return to Salt Springs, FL so they can hop on a plane and go to Alaska on a cruise with Delray Elks Tim and Mitzi Garrito. It is a rarity and a blessing to travel for the last 3 years with a couple that we enjoy and are compatible with. You try travelling with someone for 2 – 6 months and see how you do! We are extremely lucky and grateful to be accepted as travelling "neighbors" and only wish them a fantastic trip and the Best Always. I'm sure they will find a Friendly Elks Lodge somewhere! They are truly Elks Ambassadors and a shining example of what it is to be a DELRAY ELK!




