



"MESSAGE FROM YOUR ER"



Members all,

Happy February, everyone! February is the 11th month of the Elk year. It is a time when preparations for the upcoming Elk year are made, including collecting the dues to help finance the Lodge operations and electing the officers who will run the Lodge during the 2024-2025 year.

Also, progress is being made in finding a contractor who can repair the roof without requiring us to modify our mortgage.

Dues: The dues notifications were sent out by Grand Lodge in late January. The total dues increased from \$140.00 to \$145.00. Grand Lodge increased their annual insurance assessment by \$5.00 due to an anticipated increase in premiums and claims. This increase was announced at the last Grand Lodge convention and mentioned in this column in last August's newsletter.

Our Lodge's portion of the dues remains the same at \$107.00. The other \$38.00 (up from \$33.00) of our annual dues goes to the Grand Lodge to cover per capita dues, assessments, and fees. The dues that the Lodge receives for the next fiscal year cannot be spent until the next fiscal year begins. In other words, we cannot access these funds until April 1.

To thank those who pay their dues early, the Lodge will host a Duesday Tuesday event on February 20. The Lodge will buy a drink (not top shelf) on February 20 for everyone who has paid

ELK OF THE MONTH

The Elk of the Month for February is Janet Meeks. Janet is the Lodge's grants coordinator. In this role she submits applications and proposals to the Elks National



Foundation and the Florida State Elks Association and addresses any questions or concerns that they may have about the application . Some of the grants require that the Lodge partner with a charity that will be the ultimate recipient of the grant money. Janet researches the charities, selects the ones that will be good fits, and designs projects that meet the grant criteria.

Janet's most recent efforts resulted in the Lodge receiving a \$4,000 grant from the FSEA and a \$6,000 Beacon Grant from ENF. Half of the FSEA grant will fund scholarships that the Lodge gives to deserving Atlantic High School seniors. The other half will go to the VA Fresh and Healthy Teaching Kitchen program to help veterans facing food insecurity.

The Beacon Grant paid for the supplies needed for the hygiene kits that Lodge members packed for the Living Hungry program last December. This was the second year in a row that Janet obtained funding for these hygiene kits.

By obtaining these grants and implementing these projects, the Lodge is able to support local charities while at the same time enhancing our reputation in the community – all at no cost to the Lodge. Thank you and congratulations, Janet!

their dues on or before that date. If you pay prior to the 20th, you will need to bring proof of payment in order to receive a free drink.

Officer elections: Nominations for officers will be made during the February 13 Lodge meeting and the election will take place during the February 27 meeting. The officers will be installed at 7pm on March 23, with a dinner following the installation.

Roof repairs: The Building Repair Fund balance is currently \$20,604.54. We are currently waiting on proposals from two different contractors. These proposals will include solutions for stopping the leaks without replacing the entire roof. It is expected that the proposals will be submitted in the next week or so. The Board of Directors will select one of them. That proposal will then be submitted to the members for their review and approval.

While the proposal is expected to cost significantly less than the \$115,000 cost of a new roof, it will probably exceed the current Fund balance. Donations to the Fund are still welcome, and can be made online at delrayelks.org, in person with the bartender, or through the mail by sending checks payable to BPOE Lodge 1770 to Patti Lydon, the Lodge Secretary.

CHARITY SPOTLIGHT

VETERANS ADMINISTRATION FRESH/HEALTHY TEACHING KITCHEN PROGRAMS

Billie Smith, Healthy Teaching Kitchen Coordinator states that The VA Fresh/HTK program is incredibly important to us as it aims to help food-insecure areas in Palm Beach County. We've been able to reach over 100 food in-secure Veterans with our program in the past eight months, and our goal is to continue expanding our reach by actively engaging with the community. Below is a brief description of the two programs (VA Fresh and Healthy Teaching Kitchen).

At **VA Fresh**, we believe that lack of access to nutritious food can have serious and long-lasting effects on health and well-being. This can make it challenging for those facing hunger to manage chronic conditions. *Our mission is to ensure that all Veterans have access to nutritious, affordable, and culturally appropriate food to support their overall health.*

Choosing healthy foods is essential for good health, and learning to cook can help you make better food choices. The **Healthy Teaching Kitchen** (HTK) program aims to provide Veterans with nutrition knowledge, cooking skills, and guided practice to build confidence in cooking healthy, minimally processed foods at home.

Delray Beach Lodge #1770 supports these programs by providing a donation from a grant received from Florida State Elks Association.



ROLES OF ELKS OFFICERS

Exalted Ruler - The 'President'. Elected by Lodge members. Executive Officer of the Lodge and enforces and performs duties required by the Laws of the Order and the By-Laws of the Lodge. The ER appoints all committees and has general supervision over all matters pertaining to the Lodge.

Leading Knight - '1st Vice-President'. Elected by Lodge members. Assists the Exalted Ruler in the performance of his/her duties. Will officiate in the absence of the ER.

Loyal Knight - '2nd Vice President'. Elected by Lodge members. Second in command in the absence of the ER.

Lecturing Knight - '3rd Vice President'. Elected by Lodge members. Third in command in the absence of the ER.

Secretary - Elected by Lodge Members. Records minutes of Lodge meetings, maintains lodge accounts, reads/answers all correspondence, administers membership cards.

Treasurer - Elected by Lodge Members. Receives all monies from the Secretary and Members, pays approved bills of the Lodge, maintains record of receipts and disbursements, and signs all checks.

Tiler - Appointed by the ER. Stationed at the door of the Lodge at all meetings, he/she permits no person to enter without previous announcement and permission from the Exalted Ruler.

Esquire - Appointed by the ER. Is stationed to the right of the Exalted Ruler during Lodge meetings. He/She organizes the Lodge, prepares candidates for initiation and introduces visiting members.

Chaplain - Appointed by the ER. Stationed to the left of the Exalted Ruler during Lodge meetings. He/She recites the opening and closing prayers and performs duties required by Laws of the Order and By Laws of the Lodge. Leads funeral rites for deceased members.

Inner Guard - Appointed by the ER. Positioned at the inner door during Lodge meetings, allows only those qualified to enter.

Trustees - Elected by Lodge members. Trustees control funds and property of the Lodge and hold regular monthly meetings, keep a record of all investments and purchase of all Lodge supplies and presents an annual Lodge budget.
