June has been a busy month for us as we are in full swing with our travel "neighbors", JL and Michele Snowden, as we have been skipping along our route through eastern part of Mid American. As usual, we have been visiting breweries, distilleries, landmarks, nature trails, and, of course, fellow Elks Lodges whenever possible. This month for the first time we happened to stay at three in a row that were conveniently located along our path and nearby our points of interest.

First was Westlake, Ohio Lodge #1350 who had two electric hookups for us. They were only twelve miles from our destination of Cleveland, OH. We never had been there before and it's a cool sports city. The baseball and basketball complexes are next to each other and less than a mile away from the football stadium and Rock 'n Roll Hall of Fame which were next to each other. Filled a whole day seeing the Commanders (lousy name) play and checking out the Rock 'n Roll Hall of Fame. The members of the Lodge gave us tips for going into the city that were invaluable...ANOTHER bonus of being an Elk! We were only there a couple of nights and they were great to us.

Second was Erie, PA Lodge #67 with three hookups. It was also a half mile from Presque Isle State Park, a 14 mile paved bike ride along Lake Erie and opposite Bay with many a beach access stops along the way. A magnificent bike ride on a gorgeous sunny cool day. This was a busy Lodge that has something every night. The three all ate at the Lodge and loved the food. As usual, many people came up to us and introduced themselves. They all couldn't help but see our big purple Elks flag mounted on our Airstream.

Third was Lockport, NY Lodge #41 where we stayed a week just like last year. Loved seeing some of the same friendly faces! A great stop that is nearby Buffalo (for a concert), Niagara Falls, and a paved trail that goes along the Erie Canal all the way to Albany. 
