



BAD NEWS FOR THE LODGE



The recent heavy rains exposed major leaks in our Lodge building, The ballroom suffered extreme water leakage resulting in the cancellation of scheduled events in the room. The ladies' restroom in the lounge area also experienced water leakage.

A fund raiser has been in place for quite some time in an effort to obtain the necessary funds to make the required long term roof repairs. The band aid approach is no longer working. The roof resurfacing is a major undertaking and expensive. It must be done NOW!

Unlike other commercial building in which the landlord can raise rents to cover needed repairs, the Lodge does not have that luxury. Our dues are used for normal operating expenses and do not totally cover them. Those expenses are covered through bar sales, games, raffles, dinners, etc. Major expenses must be paid for by generous donations from the membership. We must once again ask our members for their help.

The Lodge is nearly \$7000 short of having the necessary funds to fix the roof. Your previous generous contributions have covered about \$26,000 of the total cost. If possible, please reach into your pockets and donate what you can. Don't wait, it's needed now. The Lodge cannot borrow the money for the repairs nor can we count on our operating budget to cover the costs. Only you can make this work. Donations can be made through the bartenders or on our website at delrayelks.org. Please help!





THE RETURN OF THE WANDERING ELKS

Greeting Fellow Elks of Delray Beach Lodge #1770,

The previous 2 years, I've been chronicling my wife's, Herri, and my Airstream journey during our 6-7 months across various parts of the beautiful USA.

I only have been telling about Elks Lodges that we have stopped at to either camp or just visit on our way (we have visited 26 and stayed at 12!!) Any other info tales can be

found on my POLARSTEPS free blog, which is an awesome way to privately post your adventures to friends and family only with lots of pictures. If interested, please email me for instructions.

In 2022, we went west to the Grand Canyon, Yellowstone and most of the national parks in that area. Last year, 2023, took us to the east coast cities up to Portland, Maine. This year, 2024, has us going up the eastern part of the center time zone through the Bourbon Trail...and that we sure did. We have been gone for almost 2 months as of this writing (June 1) and we have made it just past Columbus, Ohio. Our usual travel mates, Michele Snowden and her husband (still Delray Beach Elk living in Salt Spring, FL) won't catch up to us until this weekend. They are not far behind and are currently in Louisville, KY where they visited Lodge #8. The bartender just so happened to work at Churchill Downs, home of the Derby. They went to the Thursday twilight racing and had a blast!

So far, Herri and I have only been to 4 Lodges this trip, not by choice though. Sometimes we were around when they were closed or just too far away to visit...it happens. First one was in Sebring, FL, who used to host the Elks State Golf Tourney...it's a nice lodge right on the lake and a short drive from Highland Hammock State Park (oldest in Florida) where we were camping. It's a great place for sunset cocktails. We met ex-Delray Beach Elks Cindy and Henry Hoyman too.

Second was a favorite of ours where we stayed almost a week - Biloxi, MS #606 (right across the street from the bay!) where we met up with ex-Delray Beach Elks Tina and BJ Jordan. They are actually members of Lodge #2501 in Ocean Spring, MS, just over the causeway. They have a remarkable tale of surviving Hurricane Katrina that actually destroyed their Lodge with an over 20 foot storm surge. They had to rebuild the lodge on concrete reinforced pylons a few hundred yard up the road. They were very proud of their resilience and had pictures and stories that were quite impressive. Congrats to them!

Third was the 1400 acre with a lake Lodge #599 in Hattiesburg, MS. This has gotta be one of the biggest pieces of land in Elkdom...58 campsites, most with hook ups and a big pool! We got a cart ride throughout the whole impressive property that has tons of wildlife. I have to thank PERs Les and Cecil for the big purple banner that I hang on a trailer awning that states who we are. A whole lot of Elks stopped by us in the bar to thank us for coming and identifying where we are from. Glad I thought of it and the Lodge for giving it!

Fourth was Franklin, TN where we also stayed 2 years ago. They have completely upgraded their lounge into a pleasing experience unlike the "1970's Holiday Inn" look a lot of the outdated lodges look like. You want new members, you gotta upgrade the facilities like we do.

Ok, that's a lot of catching up. Hopefully we will hit more in the next month. Until then....


