WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A DELRAY BEACH ELK?

The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks (BPOE), of which Delray Beach Lodge is a part of, was founded in 1868, over 146 years ago. The word "Benevolent" means "well-meaning and kindly". For organizations, it means "serving a charitable rather than a profit-making purpose".

As a benevolent organization, our members are asked continually to contribute to various causes. Sometimes, the members feel they are constantly being "nickeled and dimed to death". But is that really the case?

Donating is a personal choice not a requirement to be a member of the Delray Beach Elks. Although we would like everyone to donate to every event or thing you're asked to donate to, we know that is not possible or likely to occur nor do we expect it. We only ask that you donate when you can and what you can.

There are a multitude of choices when you do decide to contribute. We have national Elks fund raisers, Florida Association Elks fund raisers, and our local Elks fund raisers. You can do one-time donations or reoccurring donations. You can make small donations or large donations. All we ask is that you do donate if and when you can.

Donating financially is not the only way you can contribute. Volunteering your time to the various functions is another way of donating. We know your time is as valuable as money. Volunteerism is the backbone of our Lodge. Without our volunteers, many of the events held could not occur.

Even if you are not into making direct donations to one of the events, supporting the Lodge with your presence is another form of donating. Buying a drink or a dinner or attending one of our events goes a long way in supporting the Lodge. If only half of our over 800 members attended the Lodge on a regular basis, many of our operating expenses for the Lodge would be covered.

Never think you are being "nickeled or dimed to death". Make your choices based on your feelings and what YOU wish to support. You are not judged on what you donate or how much you donate. We do not take names on whether or not you buy a raffle ticket, attend an event, purchase a drink, or play bingo or Queen of Hearts. Do what you can, when you can.

Although it's never mentioned enough, everything you do to support the Lodge in anyway is always greatly appreciated. You are part of a great organization and often times are unsung heroes.


