"Elks will continue to honor and support our country's veterans. It is a pleasant task we have chosen for ourselves and we hold it as most sacred."

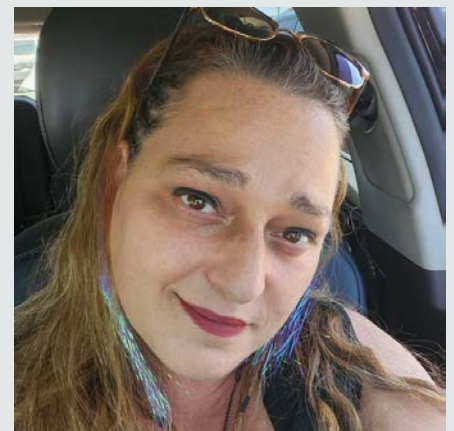


