\$17,185.32, Pre-paid Dues \$300.37 for a total of \$103,916.24. The board along with our Treasure Carol Eaton, and our Secretary Linda Roman, her assistant Kimberly Van Zant have spent countless hours working to trim our costs during the shutdown and will continue to do so until we can re-open.

### The Elks National Foundation Scholarships

#### Most Valuable Student Scholarships

Each year, the Elks National Foundation awards five hundred Most Valuable Student Scholarships. Applications are available August 15th. For details on these four-year college scholarships, ranging from \$4000 to \$50,000. Visit [www.elks.org/enf/scholars](http://www.elks.org/enf/scholars)

**Eligibility:** Any high school senior who is a US citizen can apply

**Deadline:** Applications must be submitted by November 5, 2020 online

#### Legacy Award

Through ENF Legacy Awards, each year, 250 children and grandchildren of Elks members receive four-year scholarships worth \$4000 each.

**Eligibility:** College bound high school seniors who are children or grandchildren of dues-paying Elks can apply.

**Deadline:** Applications must be submitted online on or before 11:59 am central time on January 31, 2021

#### Emergency Education Grants

ENF Emergency Grants provide college financial assistance to the children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year grants of up to \$4000.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be attending an accredited US College or University as a full-time student, demonstrate financial need, and be unmarried and under the age of 23 on December 31.

**Deadline:** Applications must be submitted by October 31, 2020 at the lodge where the applicant's parent is or was a member.
