Hope Scholarship

The mission of the Florida State Elks Association HOPE Scholarship is to provide financial support for the educational needs of Florida high school seniors without which they would not be able to achieve their educational goals. The scholarship targets students who demonstrated leadership through participation in school activities, community service, and citizenship. Consideration is given to those students who have shouldered extra responsibility such as working throughout their high school careers to help provide support of siblings or family.

The 2020/2021 application period will open September 1, 2020 with applications due by January 10, 2021.

Van Duren Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund is a program of the Florida Elks Youth Camp and the Florida State Elks Association. The fund provides scholarships in amounts up to \$5,000 per year to graduating high school/home schooled seniors who are planning to attend college and to students currently enrolled in an accredited American college, university or community college. To be eligible, you must have served as an employee of the Florida Elks Youth Camp summer camp program for at least one season prior to submitting an application. If awarded the scholarship, you will only receive that award the fall semester AFTER your second summer of work. The 20120/2021 application period will open November 15, 2020 with applications due by January 15, 2021.

We are in the process of upgrading our menus, food quality, and service at the Lodge. We need volunteers to work in the kitchen for at least one shift per month, more would be great. We are working on improving our lodge experience to everyone's enjoyment. In the long run, we will all benefit by allowing us to help our community.

Job duties will include dish washing which will be a minimum of pans and utensils, putting kitchen equipment back where they are kept and assisting server with meal deliveries. Serving requires carrying completed dishes out to the bar or to tables, you will not be responsible for taking orders for food or drinks or entering information on our point-of-sale system, and returning utensils to the dish station in the kitchen. Expediting will be examining the order ticket, matching with the plate, garnishing, and adding condiments. Aprons will be provided. No experience needed but welcomed. We will train.

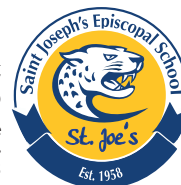
