Message from the Exalted Ruler



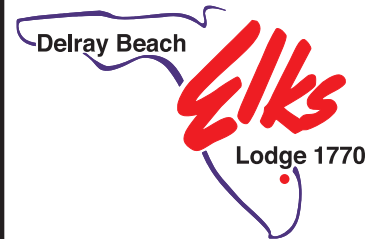
My Fellow Elks, I hope this finds you and your well.

First and foremost, I must express my complete gratitude to everyone who helped make the past few months of meals possible. Their efforts have taught me that when things get tough Elkdom shines like the Star above the alter. While their efforts have been above and beyond the true stars are those of you that came to purchase every Monday and Friday demonstrating one of our cardinal principals

as Elks Brotherly Love, because of your generosity we were able to donate 4000 dollars to Trinity Church who in turn has been able to supply thousands of free meals to those in need in our community. In this time of uncertainty, your efforts show what Elkdom is all about. Thank You!!

The million-dollar question. When will the lodge re-open? I anticipate by the time you receive this newsletter that we will be open in some fashion. We are waiting on word from the Governor as to phase 2. The reporting that we have heard will allow us to open up at either 25% or 50% capacity. What does this mean for us? First, our capacity in the club is 200 people that would mean that at the beginning of opening we could have 50 to 100 people in the club. We have anticipated this and re-arranged the furniture in the club to abide by social distancing as best we could. Bingo will be open to members only on both Wednesday and Saturday with limited seating. Queen of Hearts will have a rule change eliminating the percentage taken for a member not being present, due to diminished member capacity. In the beginning, we will not be able to allow members to bring guests with them to accommodate as many members as we can. As I stated in the opening of this statement we have not gotten official word from our Governor, State Elks Association, or Grand Lodge as to opening procedures. The only thing that the officers, Board, and I are concerned with is the health and safety of all of you. Thank you in advance for your understanding.
