My fellow Elks,



Elks Care Elks Share. Members Helping Members: Volunteers needed

We want to provide more for our Lodge, but we need your help. I will personally contact those of you that expressed interest in helping in the kitchen.

Along with myself, we have Chef Dave Hoover and Chef Walter Firstmeyer and we have just welcomed Donna Barron-Baker, Darlene Frey and Lee Berkowitz to the kitchen.

We will be scheduling a day dedicated to cleaning and reorganizing. This will be a call to all members that can spare a couple of hours to help accomplish this.

We have upgraded the 5.3-ounce Black Angus burgers to 8 ounces. Our BIG HOTDOG has returned to the menu. We added Chicken Wings to Sundays menu. Queen of Hearts/Friday evenings we added Fish and Chips with Tartar Sauce or Malt Vinegar, Calamari with Marinara Sauce and Panko Breaded Butterfly Shrimp with curry shrimp sauce.

The Guest Chef program held on Monday Evenings has drawn interest. We are limiting our servings to about 48 dishes. When we run out, the kitchen closes. On February 15th, Dave and Paula Augustine, visiting members from the Waldorf Maryland area prepared a sold-out dinner of thick cut porkchops, mashed potatoes with gravy, mexican corn and dump cake. On the following Monday, Laura Schraeder served her Beef Stroganoff, green beans with bacon, a romaine side salad and brownies with a scoop of ice cream. I followed the next week with baked stuffed peppers and a pasta side, with Apple Brown Betty for dessert. Hitting March 8 will be newly elected trustee and Elk of the Month Walter Firstmeyer with lasagna rollups and a romaine side salad.

If you would like to become a guest chef, please contact us for assistance. We will assist you in large scale cooking. Your recipe, Our expertise.

Wednesday, March 17th from 5:30 – 7:00 pm we will serve St. Patrick's Dinner. On the menu will be Corned Beef, Cabbage, Boiled Potatoes, Irish Soda Bread and Guinness Chocolate Mousse. The standard Bingo menu will be available at 7:00 pm.

We will have a weekly update posted to our Facebook page and send out to everyone that we have an email address for. We will also update our webpage (www.delrayelks.org).
