Elks Beacon Grant 2020

The Delray Beach Elks Lodge received a \$3500 Beacon Grant from the Elks National Foundation to help our community with covid 19 related issues. We chose to split the funds with Living Hungry and The City of Delray Beach Delray Reads.

In June, Living Hungry teamed up with Cason United Methodist Church, Trinity Church, Avenue Church, St. Matthews, St. Paul's and others to unload 2 Semi Tractor Trailers of groceries into Delray Beach every week- gifts from the USDA Farmers to Families Food Boxes (FFFB) program. Today they feed 2,774 families with 20 lbs. of fresh produce, milk, cheese, and meat every week.

Living Hungry plans to continue to bring donated food boxes into Delray Beach in September and October with Round Three from the USDA funded FFFB. They get the food donated, but all of the expenses of the distributions are not covered. Costs include forklift and pallet jack rentals, equipment, water and snacks, even insurance.

The City of Delray's Delray Reads Day is more important than ever this year to help raise awareness around the importance of reading at an early age. This year the City will join the nation in a Leaning Loss Recovery Challenge as a call to action to acknowledge and confront the very real threat presented by the "COVID-19" slide. Unless mitigated and reversed, the pandemic-predicted learning loss will dramatically affect children from economically challenged families and become a lasting legacy of COVID-19.

The donations from the Elks and other sponsors will be used to purchase 1600 Books at \$4.00 each to be delivered to every child in pre-K through 1st grade.

Eligibility: College bound high school seniors who are children or grandchildren od dues-paying Elks can apply. **Deadline:** Applications must be submitted online on or before 11:59 am central time on January 31, 2021.

Emergency Education Grants

ENF Emergency Grants provide college financial assistance to the children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year grants of up to \$4000.

Eligibility: Applicants must be attending an accredited US College or University as a full-time student, demonstrate financial need, and be unmarried and under the age of 23 on December 31.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted by October 31, 2020 at the lodge where the applicant's parent is or was a member.

Hope Scholarship

The mission of the Florida State Elks Association HOPE Scholarship is to provide financial support for the educational needs of Florida high school seniors without which they would not be able to achieve their educational goals. The scholarship targets students who demonstrated leadership through participation in school activities, community service, and citizenship. Consideration is given to those students who have shouldered extra responsibility such as working throughout their high school careers to help provide support of siblings or family.

The 2020/2021 application period will open September 1, 2020 with applications due by January 10, 2021.

Van Duren Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund is a program of the Florida Elks Youth Camp and the Florida State Elks Association. The fund provides scholarships in amounts up to \$5,000 per year to graduating high school/home schooled seniors who are planning to attend college and to students currently enrolled in an accredited American college, university or community college. To be eligible, you must have served as an employee of the Florida Elks Youth Camp summer camp program for at least one season prior to submitting an application. If awarded the scholarship, you will only receive that award the fall semester AFTER your second summer of work. The 20120/2021 application period will open November 15, 2020 with applications due by January 15, 2021.
