Most Valuable Student Scholarships

Each year, the Elks National Foundation awards five hundred Most Valuable Student Scholarships. Applications are available August 15th. For details on these four-year college scholarships, ranging from \$4000 to \$50,000. Visit www.elks.org/enf/scholars.

Eligibility: Any high school senior who is a US citizen can apply.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted by November 5, 2020 online.

Legacy Award

Through ENF Legacy Awards, each year, 250 children and grandchildren of Elks members receive four-year scholarships worth \$4000 each.

Eligibility: College bound high school seniors who are children or grandchildren of dues-paying Elks can apply. **Deadline:** Applications must be submitted online on or before 11:59 am central time on January 31, 2021.

Emergency Education Grants

ENF Emergency Grants provide college financial assistance to the children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year grants of up to \$4000.

Eligibility: Applicants must be attending an accredited US College or University as a full-time student, demonstrate financial need, and be unmarried and under the age of 23 on December 31.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted by October 31, 2020 at the lodge where the applicant's parent is or was a member.

Hope Scholarship

The mission of the Florida State Elks Association HOPE Scholarship is to provide financial support for the educational needs of Florida high school seniors without which they would not be able to achieve their educational goals. The scholarship targets students who demonstrated leadership through participation in school activities, community service, and citizenship. Consideration is given to those students who have shouldered extra responsibility such as working throughout their high school careers to help provide support of siblings or family.

The 2020/2021 application period will open September 1, 2020 with applications due by January 10, 2021.

Van Duren Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund is a program of the Florida Elks Youth Camp and the Florida State Elks Association. The fund provides scholarships in amounts up to \$5,000 per year to graduating high school/home schooled seniors who are planning to attend college and to students currently enrolled in an accredited American college, university or community college. To be eligible, you must have served as an employee of the Florida Elks Youth Camp summer camp program for at least one season prior to submitting an application. If awarded the scholarship, you will only receive that award the fall semester AFTER your second summer of work. The 20120/2021 application period will open November 15, 2020 with applications due by January 15, 2021.
