Delray Beach No. 1770 2020 Bylaw Changes, December 8, 2020

Article IV: Meetings: Regular Lodge meeting shall be held on the 4th Tuesday monthly except in November and December when the meetings will be held on the second Tuesday. In February, March and April the Lodge meeting will be held on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday.

Article V: Elective Officers and Duties – of the Secretary– section 4: Increased the compensation of the secretary from \$8000.00 per annum to \$12,000.00 per annum.

Article VI: Appointive Duties and Responsibilities – of the Tiler: Changed the annual compensation to \$125.00 to reflect updated dues (including per capitas).

Article IX: Club Operations and Management: Added the following which was omitted from the prior printing: The supervising body of the Club will hire staff as appropriate to manage, serve, and clean the lounge, banquet hall and kitchen as needed.

Article X: Fees and Dues– section 1: Application fees raised to \$50.00; section 2b– dues increased to \$102.00 from \$84.00. Total cost to renew is \$125.00; section 3 – all fees increased to \$50.00.

Hope Scholarship

The mission of the Florida State Elks Association HOPE Scholarship is to provide financial support for the educational needs of Florida high school seniors without which they would not be able to achieve their educational goals. The scholarship targets students who demonstrated leadership through participation in school activities, community service, and citizenship. Consideration is given to those students who have shouldered extra responsibility such as working throughout their high school careers to help provide support of siblings or family.

The 2020/2021 application period will open September 1, 2020 with applications due by January 10, 2021.

Van Duren Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund is a program of the Florida Elks Youth Camp and the Florida State Elks Association. The fund provides scholarships in amounts up to \$5,000 per year to graduating high school/home schooled seniors who are planning to attend college and to students currently enrolled in an accredited American college, university or community college. To be eligible, you must have served as an employee of the Florida Elks Youth Camp summer camp program for at least one season prior to submitting an application. If awarded the scholarship, you will only receive that award the fall semester AFTER your second summer of work. The 2020/2021 application period will open November 15, 2020 with applications due by January 15, 2021.

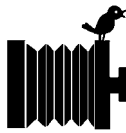

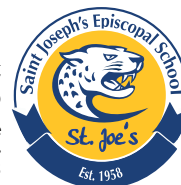
