






CALIFORNIA HISTORY TOUR

- Sailing Brig Pilgrim & Richard Henry Dana Come see the famous sailing ship that plied the California coast in search of hides for the New England Market. Learn about life aboard this 1834 vessel, and the man who made it famous.
- ✓ Mission San Luis Rey Lunch and Tour Despite its proximity, many people have not seen this beautiful 1798 mission, built in the Spanish Colonial, Classical and Baroque style. We'll enjoy lunch in the Mission grounds prior to a tour that includes the historic church, lavanderia, convent, cemetery and extensive museum. The Mission was declared a National Historic Landmark in 1970. Includes lunch: hot entrée, salad bar, drink and dessert. Veggie option on request.
