- ✓ **Enjoy a 90-minute tour on one of the most famous ships in the world - RMS Queen Mary.** Built in Scotland in 1930 by Cunard Lines, this most famous ocean liner is one of the world's best Art Deco landmarks. From its royal launch to its time as a troop ship in WW II to its golden years in the 1950s, this ship has some of the most intricate and beautiful interior designs ever aboard an ocean liner. The Art Deco design was enhanced by over 50 types of wood from all over the world.
- ✓ **Explore the Queen on your own for lunch at the Promenade Cafe** - Savor 90 minutes of free time on board the Queen for shopping, eating and photos!
- ✓ **Tour the largest adobe residence built during the Mexican period** - Built in 1844 and remodeled in the 1920s, Rancho Los Cerritos tells the story of ranch life in early California. Beautifully restored with a gorgeous garden and visitor's center, RLC was designated a National Historic Landmark - the highest honor available.
- ✓ **Activity Level** - Moderate walking.
