- Mission San Luis Rey in Oceanside Declared a National Historic Landmark, it is the only surviving Mission church laid out in the cruciform plan. Guided by the Museum Director, we will explore the historic "lavanderia", cemetery, and gardens with the oldest pepper tree in California, and have time to tour the extensive museum.
- Lunch The tour includes lunch in the Mission's historic retreat center!
- Dana Point Heading back to Dana Point, we'll stop at the historic harbor overlook and learn about the famous adventures of Richard Henry Dana who called Capistrano Bay the "most romantic spot on the California coast." We'll also learn about the dashed dreams of famous developers, including Edward Doheny, and the success of surf entrepreneurs who put Dana Point on the world surfing map.
- Five Vines Wine Bar We'll top off the day with a wonderful, three pour, wine tasting and cheese board at Five Vines Wine Bar in Los Rios Historic District in San Juan Capistrano. So much beauty – so close to home!
