



ATTENTION:

Are you a parent of a child(ren) that are under age 14 and lost SNAP benefits due to not meeting work requirement?

You are not required to meet the work requirement and should be getting *more* SNAP benefits.

- This may have impacted families where:
 - There are children under age 14 with two adults in the home, and one adult's benefits were removed because they were not meeting the work requirement of 80 hours a month.
 - For example, if you are a family of 4 with two children, one of which is under 14, after three months you would only get benefits for 3 if one of the parents is not working 80 hours a month.

If this is you, reach out to SC DSS now and ask to have your benefits *increased* to the correct amount.
