

Points to Emphasize: Public safety, crime prevention, increased crime coming to Broadmoor from other cities especially San Francisco, excellent response times when calling for service, BPD assisting other agencies such as Daly City and Colma Police Depts., long tenure/75 years protecting Broadmoor, officers supporting local events and being POSITIVE role models to our children.

What is the difference between the Police Assessment & the Annual Assessment?

- The Annual Assessment or Dues is billed by the BPOA and is used by the BPOA for community events such as the Easter Egg Hunt and the Pasta Dinner. (\$8 for 2023)
- The Police Special Assessment is on your property tax bill and creates the budget for the Broadmoor Police Department. (\$507 for 2023)
- BPD is working on 2nd Special Property Tax Assessment since the current Special Assessment has only been raised twice since it's inception decades ago.
