POLICY AND PROSPECTS

Last month Department of New York Adjutant Maurice Stember sent this letter to Post Commander O'Hara:

"We have been advised that you have been elected as Commander of your Post for the Legion year 1964-1965 and wish to extend our heartiest congratulations. May your year as Commander be a very successful one.

"Within your own area your Post is the local representation of The American Legion. What your Post does or fails to do is of much greater importance in establishing the local reputation of The American Legion than anything your Department or National Organization does. With your charter, you received the privilege of taking part in The American Legion's nation-wide programs. I urge that, as rapidly as possible, you undertake activities in the basic programs of rehabilitation, Americanism, child welfare, and national security to the full extent that they are suited to your community.

"One thing which will add greatly to the success of your year as Post Commander and the coming year in the Department is emphasis on membership. I would like to urge you to organize your membership program early in the year. We are going to try to stop the downward trend in membership this year and you as Post Commander will be the one we will be looking to in this connection. We are certain that there are many eligible men who are veterans and are just waiting for the invitation to affiliate in membership with us."

In the Department Adjutant's letter we have been given five specific fields on which to concentrate our Legion interests. They are (1) rehabilitation, (2) Americanism, (3) child welfare, (4) national security and (5) membership.

In recent years rehabilitation has not been cause for great concern in our Post. There have been a few isolated cases in which our Service Officer has been called upon to give advice and help. However, with the span of time ever increasing from our war-time service there will be an increasing demand for the calls upon the Service Officer in whose area the rehabilitation programs rest. All our members should be aware that this is one of the fundamental reasons for the existence of the American Legion. When the time comes to use the rehabilitation service

make your case known to your Post Service Officer. He is William Campbell of 264 Kenwood Avenue, Elsmere. His home phone is HE 9-3398.

This service alone is one of the main selling points for membership in the American Legion. Use this to bring in new or renewed memberships.

AMERICANISM

Americanism is something too many people take for granted — and leave unattended. Americanism programs in the American Legion take many forms. Here in Blanchard Post the most active are the Memorial Day Parade which is a community project, Boys and Girls State candidates, entrants in the American Legion Oratorical contest with the subject of "The Constitution" are but a few. This year we hope to extend our program with an anti-Communist educational forum. This will commence with the mid-September Post Meeting when two movies on the subject will be shown. This will be an open meeting and our Post members are urged to attend and bring with them adult members of their families, their neighbors and friends. This program is motivated by the thought that an enlightened citizenry is a community's asset. It is hoped that this will serve to fulfill both the Americanism and national security aims in the 1964-65 Legion program. Also, we look to this to encourage others who are eligible to join the American Legion and bring us to our membership goal.

CHILD WELFARE

Blanchard Post Auxiliary has been doing such a good job over the years with its program for child welfare that the Post members have almost become unaware of their obligations in this program. Unaware as some might be Blanchard Post has a record of which we can boast. It is reflected through the Boy Scout Troop which we sponsor, the Blanchard Post Baseball Team of which we can all take great pride for this year's championship trophy and the Children's Christmas Party, to cite a few. Fortunately, our community has less need for aid to underprivileged children than do other localities in the American Legion. There is another way, however, that we can support the child welfare program. That is by becoming an Auxiliary Member of Tamara Post 1708, Albany Coun-
