## **GRADE 12 APPLICATION FORM (PATHWAY 2/TECHNICAL PROGRAMME)**

The Grade 12, Pathway 2 Programme is designed for students who need to RESIT subjects at the CSEC level and to pursue courses including NCTVET, ONE CAPE SUBJECT and City & Guilds Mathematics & English. Students are encouraged to use the programme to enhance their opportunities for further growth and development.

### **ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS**

**Successful applicants to PRE-SIXTH FORM MUST have:**

- **One (1) to four (4)** subjects at the CSEC General Proficiency Level

### **ADDITIONAL ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS**

**Applicants may have one (1) of the following:**

- City & Guilds certification in **English Language** and **Mathematics**
- NCTVET certification

### **NON-ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS**

- Good conduct
- Accumulation of 80% attendance in Grade 11
- Involvement in Extra-curricular activities

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

- Two (2) recent passport-sized photographs (No Hair Extensions)
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of CSEC results
- Copy of NCTVET results
- Copy of City & Guilds results

Copies of last two (2) school reports. **Applications will not be processed without these. (DO NOT SUBMIT ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.)**

## GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

1. Completed application form along with the processing fee receipt of \$2,500 (non-refundable) is to be submitted to the coordinators at the Old Harbour High School on **August 14 & 15, 2024** between the hours of 10:00 A.M and 2:00 P.M.
2. An acceptance list of students who have met the requirements for the programme will be posted on the school's notice board on **Friday, August 23, 2024 @ 5:00 P.M.**
3. Interviews will be conducted on **Monday, August 26, 2024 @ 10:00 A.M.** Students may be interviewed to receive assistance with career guidance and selection of their subjects.
4. The list of successful students from the interviews will be posted on the School's Notice Board on **Wednesday, August 28, 2024 @ 5: 00 P.M.**
