

NHS TO MERGE NHS DIGITAL WITH NHS ENGLAND

The merger, which was first announced in September 2020, will now take place in January 2023.

The aim of the merger is to streamline data sharing across the NHS, improve patient care, and drive efficiencies within the health service.





VOLUNTARY SCHEME FOR BRANDED **MEDICINES** PENALISING DRUG COMPANIES

At least two drug companies have privately warned ministers that they will cease or curtail operations in the UK unless they are spared what industry leaders have dubbed a "penalising" levy designed to limit the NHS's medicines bill.








- The goal of the EU's pharmaceutical strategy, which the European Commission adopted in November 2020, is to structure the bloc's pharmaceutical industry, by pushing research, innovation and fair access to medicines for all patients.
- The current system for determining medicine prices is not transparent and does not take into account the different research and production costs between companies, according to the French Senate's European Affairs Committee.

PRICE INCREASES

Medication prices in Portugal could get more expensive as current prices no longer cover production costs.



RUSSIAN MEDIA REPORTED SHORTAGE OF TIVICAY- AN ANTI-HIV DRUG FROM THE UK'S GLAXOSMITHKLINE (GSK)

- Russian government is planning to take measures to prevent a shortage of anti-HIV drugs in the country by increasing procurements and supplies to the domestic market.
- As part of this plan, procurement procedures will be streamlined and more active efforts will be made to supply drugs to the domestic market. Additionally, pharmacies will be provided with additional funding to increase their stocks of HIV medications.





GOVERNMENT INCREASES PAYMENT MADE TO PHARMACISTS FOR DELIVERING VACCINES

pharmacists in France will be incentivised to provide a wide range of vaccines to children and adults

The move is expected to come into force in the first quarter of 2023. It follows a growing trend across Europe since the pandemic, during which pharmacists gained valuable vaccination experience
