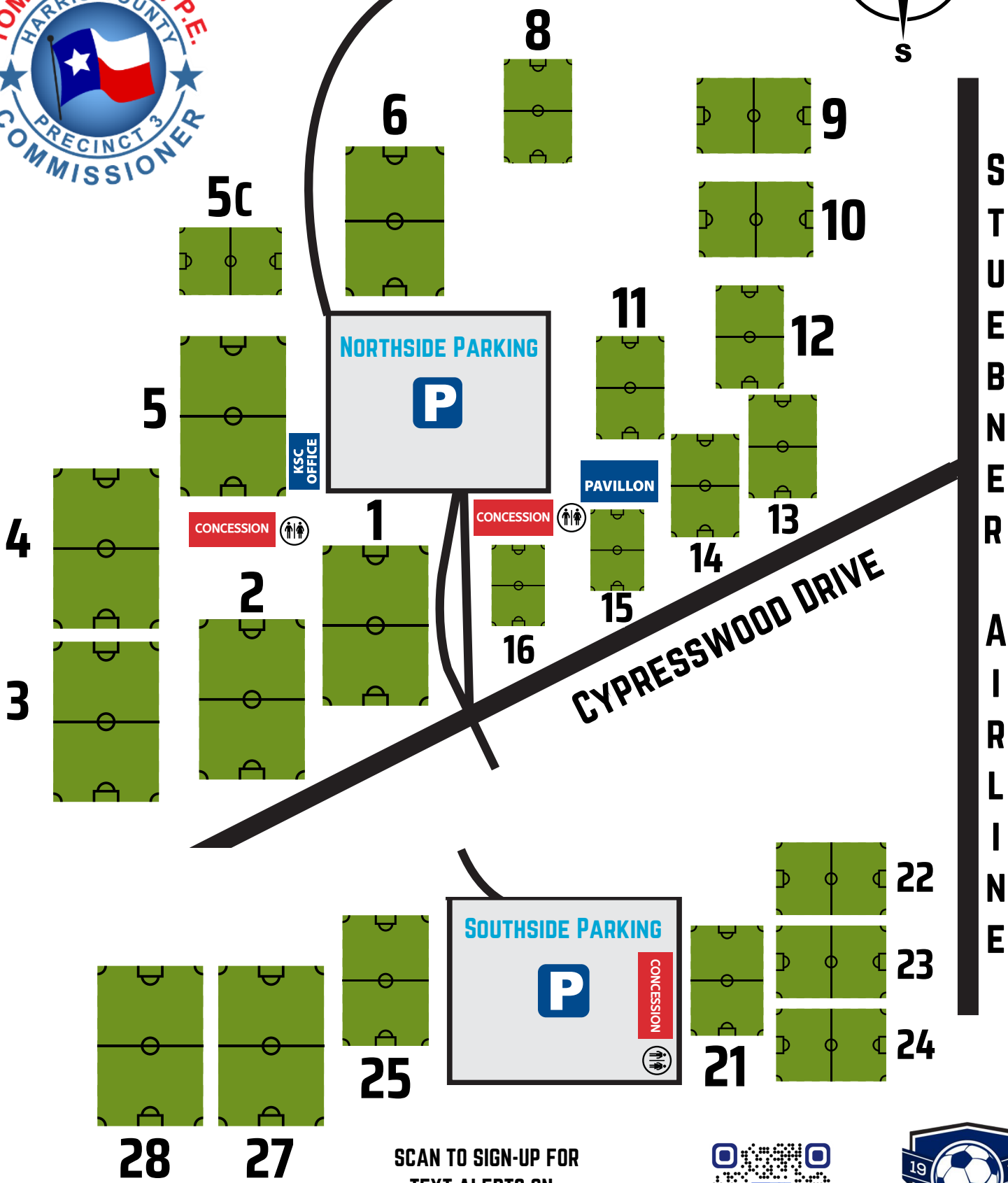
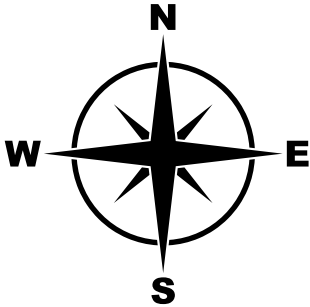

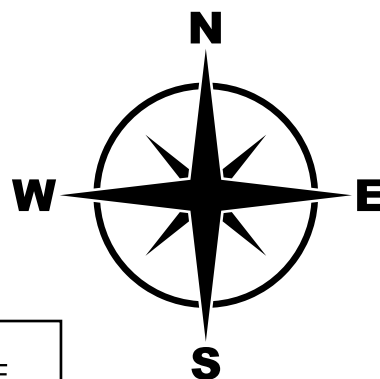


FALL 2025: FIELD MAP

PLAYER CLOTHING PROTOCOL

Additional Clothing:

Players should be allowed to dress in appropriate clothing to accommodate colder temperatures.

Please note the following on what is allowed:

- Long sleeve shirt, sweatshirt, jacket (must be worn under jersey so referee can see number).
- Long pants, tights, leggings, sweatpants.
- Gloves or mittens
- Stocking caps without straps
- Headbands
- Additional socks (under uniform socks)

The following items present a safety hazard and should **NOT** be allowed to be worn during practice or games:

- Hooded sweatshirts and hooded jackets
- Earmuffs or scarves
- Earrings or jewelry

UNIFORM INFORMATION:

- **ALL** players are required to purchase the Official Klein Soccer Club 2025/2026 Uniform Kit* (*no exceptions).
- Uniform kits are not included in registration cost and are purchased separately for \$65 online: <https://achallenge.com/clubs/klein-soccer-club/>. After purchasing - the uniform will ship within 3-5 business days.
- We recommend double checking the size chart to make sure the proper size is ordered.
- Uniform kits include a reversible jersey, shorts, and socks.
- The uniform is used for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026.
- The uniform is a light weight, breathable fabric (100% polyester). Due to reversibility, logos printed on either side may be visible when worn either way.
- No alterations to the uniform are allowed (i.e., added images, numbers, names or logos. Such items are only permitted with KSC Board approval).
- Uniforms must be purchased **NO LATER** than the second weekend of scheduled games. Failure to have the uniform, and your child will be subject to not be allowed to play.

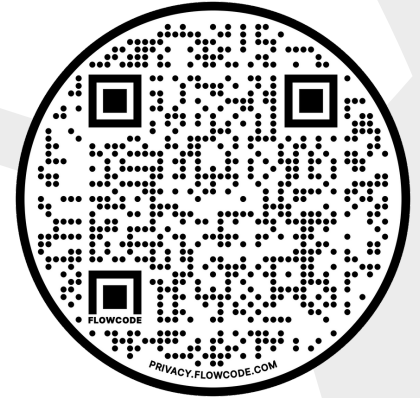

COACHING 101: COMPLETING YOUR RISK

MANAGEMENT PROFILE

In accordance with USYS and STYSA protocol, ALL Coaches/Team Managers are required to complete a 3-Part Risk Management Profile (RM Profile) to be assigned to a team. Your training/requirements include:

1. Background Check (valid for two years)
2. SafeSport Certification (every year you are required to complete a refresher course)
3. HeadsUp (CDC Concussion Awareness) Certifications (valid for two years)

It is recommended to access your account on a desktop and not a mobile device.

Please contact the Secretary/Director of Administration, Amy Ortmann (aortmannksc@gmail.com), and she will print your badge* (*seeing that all three components of your profile show as complete/fulfilled). You will pick-up your KidSafe Badge at the KSC office during office hours (see Klein Soccer Club's Facebook page or website for updated hours, as they are seasonal and subject to change).

**** Due to insurance purposes, your deadline to complete your RM Profile is the Monday following the second weekend of scheduled games. Failure to complete your profile by this date and you will not be allowed to coach.**

ALL head coaches/assistant coaches/team managers/admins are required to wear their KidSafe Badge on the sidelines and fields at ALL times. No exceptions. If you have a parent sub a game for you, they must stop by the office before the game for a temporary badge. The badge is valid for one game only, and it must be returned to the office after the game.

If you have an assistant coach that helps at practice (and plans to be on the sideline or on the field during games) - they need to complete a coaching profile as well. No exceptions.

SPECIAL UPDATE ON SAFESPORT

ATTENTION RETURNING COACHES:

SafeSport Certificates expire on May 31st annually. If you completed the SafeSport requirement prior to May 31st, you will need to take it again before the start of the 2025-2026 season, in order to be compliant.

Depending upon the last time you completed a course, you may be required to take Refresher Course 1, 2 or 3 - in that order (but not at the same time). Each Refresher Course takes 30 minutes to complete. After two full years, you are required to complete the training from the beginning. This course will take 90 minutes to 2 hours to complete. When you complete your course - please save your PDF certificate for your records.

Reminder: Without the SafeSport certification, we cannot assign you to your team, or print your KidSafe Badge.

The sooner you update your profile and complete the course - the better!

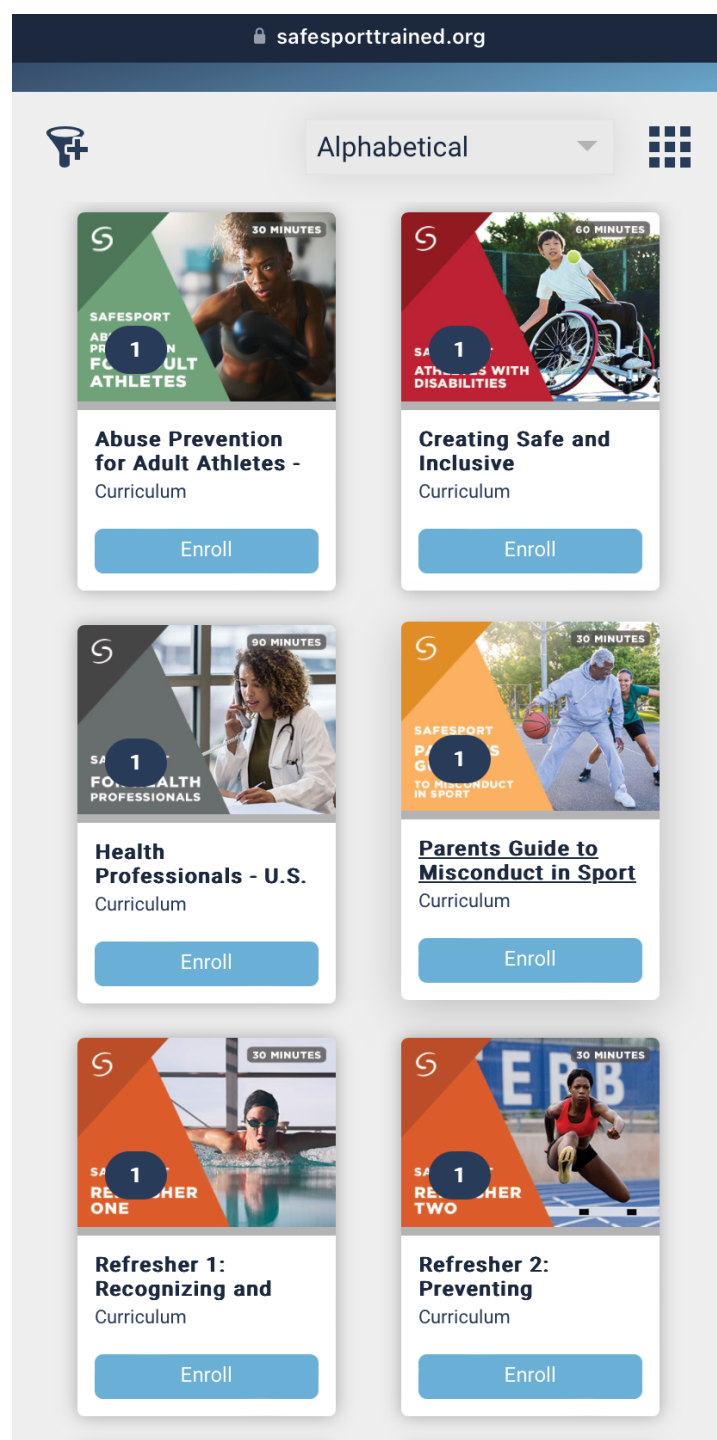
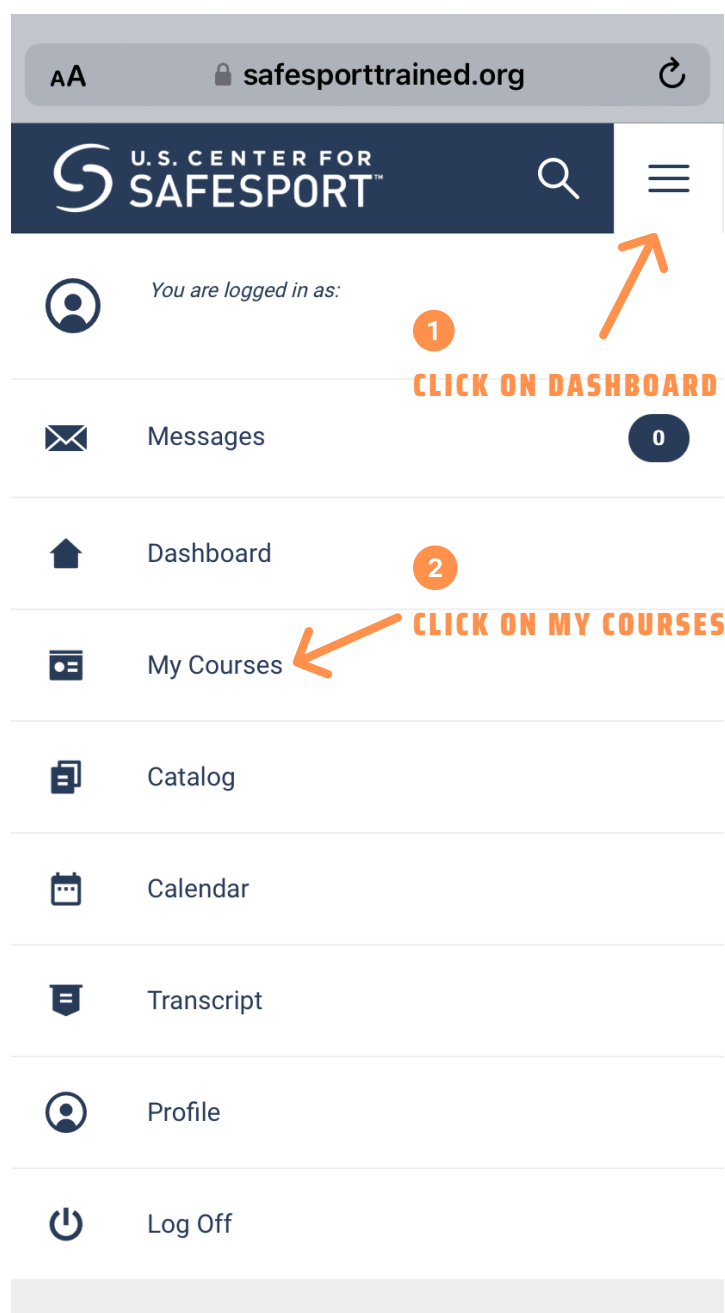

COACHING PROCEDURES AND POLICIES

Coaches are the voice for all of their players and parents. If there is any issues please communicate with your team and relay that information to the Director of Coaching, Eric Juarez, and/or the KSC Board and Staff members immediately.

Contact information for all Board Members and Staff can be located at the beginning of this handbook.

- Please review the Rules of Play on our website, and/or included in the handbook for all game rules.
- ALL head coaches/assistant coaches/team managers/admins are required to wear their KidSafe Badge on the sidelines at ALL times.
- Coaches are responsible to ensure all players get at least 50% play time during games.
- Official Klein Soccer Club uniforms must be worn on game day. On game day - the home team wears darker color/navy blue, and the away team wears lighter color/white.
- Team Name - It is not mandatory to have a team name, but you are more than welcome to create one. If you would like the team's name you've chosen to be added to GotSport you must contact the Directors of Team Formations, Erick Martinez (kleinsoccerscheduling@gmail.com) and Ivan Miranda (kleinsoccerteams@gmail.com).
- Only registered Coaches (with a completed Risk Management Profile) are allowed on the player sideline or game field.
- If you have a parent sub a game for you, they must stop by the office before the game for a temporary badge. The badge is valid for one game only, and must be returned to the office after the game.
- Spectators and players/coaches must be on the opposite sides of the field for the game to begin. Anyone who does not have a KidSafe Badge (and is registered as a coach) must remain on the opposite side of the field as the players.
- No coaches or spectators are allowed behind the goals during any games for any reasons.



COACHING PROCEDURES AND POLICIES

RESCHEDULES:

U4-U8:

Because there are no referees in these age groups, you are not required to notify the Board Members or Staff. However, as a courtesy, we do ask that you contact the opposing coach if you will not be in attendance. You are welcome to discuss playing your scheduled game during your scheduled practice time/day instead.

U9+:

All reschedule requests are required to be emailed to the Director of Scheduling, Erick Martinez - kleinsoccerscheduling@gmail.com - no later than Monday night before the scheduled game.

Both coaches must be included on the email. The first two weeks of the season schedule are locked, and no reschedules will be allowed.

Reschedules are based on field availability and not guaranteed.

- Coaches may contact or visit the office during hours, to obtain the opposing coach's contact information. OR, they can email the office staff to obtain the information - office.ksctexas@gmail.com.
- Coaches requesting a game reschedule are to contact the opposing coach and work out a mutually agreeable date and time with each other that does not conflict with other games scheduled.
- Games will **NOT** be rescheduled if both coaches have not agreed to the reschedule.
- If the opposing coach will not agree to the reschedule, the game will be played on the original date / and the opposing team will forfeit.



COACHING REMINDERS

Your number one priority is the kid's safety at all times. It's critical to keep your players hydrated and give them proper rest time during games (as well as practice). Allow for water breaks to prevent any heat-related injuries. Please have your KidSafe Badge visible at all times.

Please be respectful and responsible with the number of goals your team scores. You are all a direct representation of Klein Soccer Club. You are all looked up to regarding sportsmanship and discipline on the field. If your team is gaining a significant lead in score, please try to rotate your players around to try new positions or make them pass a certain number of times before they are allowed to shoot the ball. Do your best to keep the league positive and fun for everyone.

COACHING RESOURCES AND SUPPORT:

The KSC Board has many coaching tools available if you are unsure on how to run practices or what to do on game days. Please contact, the Director of Coaching, Eric Juarez for assistance - kleinsoccercoaches@gmail.com.

PARENTS AND SPECTATORS:

As a coach it is your job to manage your parents and spectators. Before the game starts make sure all of your parents and spectators are on the opposite side of the field as your players. In addition, there are no spectators allowed behind the goal mounds during the game. If there are any parents or spectators that are beginning to get out of hand, please try to remedy the situation as soon as possible.

If you ever have a situation of spectators or parents becoming out of control, please contact any KSC staff as soon as possible to provide assistance. The office is open from 7:30am-2pm on game days. The office number is 281-320-2211.



COACHING REMINDERS CONTINUED

GAME DAY:

Please arrive early to the park for all of your games. It is highly recommended to arrive at least 20 - 30 minutes early to your game time. Parking can become very limited and take much longer than expected to try and find a spot. This also allows for your players to properly warm up prior to the match.

All matches are about the kids having fun and developing their skills. Do not purposely try to run the score up as high as possible and make the other team want to quit the sport. Please be respectful and responsible with the number of goals your team scores. If your team is gaining a significant lead in score rotate your players around to try new positions or make them pass a certain number of times before they are allowed to shoot the ball. Do your best to keep the league positive and fun for everyone.

REFEREES (applicable to U9+ only):

Referees will not be perfect every single game. If you have any questions regarding rules, or if you have an issue with a referees calls during a game - please contact Chris Ellender, the Director of Referees - cellender@kleinsoccer.com. Everything will go much smoother if a coach contacts the KSC Board to come access a referee's performance and subsequently, handle any issues.



U4-U8 REMINDERS:

- **Your main responsibility is to coach your kids - not to referee the game.**
- **U4 to U8 matches are not allowed to have goalies. Do your best to keep all of the kids actively involved in the match and not have them stand in front of the goal. The main focus of these matches is for the kids to have fun and not focus on how many goals are scored.**
- **Teams are only allowed to have 4 players on the field with no goalie. Do not allow your entire team to play on the field at the same time.**
- **Only one to two (max) volunteer coaches from each team are allowed on the field during the game. Please encourage parents to stay off the field to ensure safety for all participating players.**
- **If the ball goes out bounds at this age group, the ball is brought back to the edge of the touch line to the closest point it went out of bounds and thrown* OR kicked* back into play. U6+ age groups will all**
 - **Throw-Ins*: U4-U6 ONLY (*don't be concerned about being stringent on throwing form. Do make sure the throw in is from the point the ball went out and from behind the boundary line. Players should not be allowed to throw the ball to themselves.)**
 - **Kick-Ins*: U7-U8 ONLY (*the ball needs to be kicked below the knee.)**
 - **U7 to U8 only:**
 - **A corner kick occurs when the defending team kicks the ball out of bounds on the goal line.**
 - **A goal kick occurs when the attacking team kicks the ball out of bounds on the goal line.**
 - **A throw in occurs when the ball is kicked out of bounds on the touch line (side lines).**
- **If you believe there is a foul or infraction please do not try to stop the game and dictate the game yourself. Should what you believe is a foul or handled ball occurs, do not stop the game and award a free kick. Rather, allow the flow of the game to continue and verbally correct the offending player. If a player continues to foul another player after your attempts to intervene/correct - immediately have them sit out and ask for their parent/guardian to provide support.**

U9 AND UP REMINDERS:

- **Your games have appointed referees.**
- **Both coaches should print their own copy for every game and fill in the required information for your team roster including goals scored during the game (do not worry about jersey numbers for the opposing team).**
- **Bring the sheet and a pen with you to the fields. Get referee information at the start of your game. The signature of the opposing teams coach is required on your game sheet. At the end of the game when your players are doing their "Good Game Exchange" take the time to sign both game sheets with the other coach.**
- **Please remember to double check accuracy before signing the opposing team sheet.**
- **It is your responsibility to turn in your game sheet after each game. See the next few pages for instructions on how to access and print your game sheet.**
- **You will deliver your game sheet to the club house - there's a clear box on the counter. If you stop by the office after 2p.m. - please drop the game sheet in the door slot.**
- **The staff is responsible to input your game scores in GotSport. When they return to the office on Monday, they will input any scores that are left over from the weekend.**

KSC COMMUNITY CODE OF CONDUCT

- **Players, coaches/team managers/admins, and spectators are expected to conduct themselves within the spirit AND the letter of the LAW. Displays of temper or dissent are cause for ejection from the game and surrounding field area. A misconduct report will be reported to STYSA and/or the team's state association. Coaches/team managers are responsible for the conduct of their team and supporters both on and off the fields.**
- **U9+ GAMES ONLY:**
 - **Yellow Cards:** A player or coach receiving two yellow cards during a match is suspended from that match and shall be suspended from the next match. In the event this occurs, players and coaches must follow the instructions as outlined in the next paragraph.
 - **Red Card/Ejection:** A player or coach/team manager receiving a red card/ejection is suspended from the match and shall be suspended from the next match. Players or coaches receiving a red card/ejection must leave the match immediately and report to the Klein Soccer Club office. The ejected player or coach must complete a game ejection form and turn in the completed form to the staff member at the office. Players may sit on the bench during their suspension; however they shall not be in uniform. Coaches/team managers must not return to the game/tournament site during the match for which they are serving the one game suspension.
- **Uniforms are not allowed to be altered (i.e., added images or logos are only permitted with KSC Board approval).**
- **Parents, fans or supporters in attendance at a KSC game or hosted event subject themselves to the jurisdiction of the D&P Committee and the KSC Board, which shall include investigation and disciplinary action. Parents with grievances against their own coach or team should first work through 1) their coach and 2) the Director of Coaches to resolve any complaints before filing a grievance to the Club President (D&P Chairman).**



KSC COMMUNITY CODE OF CONDUCT

- **Parents and players must be on opposing sides of the field. Only Coaches/Team Managers/Admins with an up-to-date KidSafe Badge are permitted to be on the player sideline during a match.**
- **No parents, fans or supporters allowed behind the goals during a match.**
- **Spectators, parents, fans, or supporters of any KSC team who are sent away from the field of play by a referee or a competition official shall receive an immediate one (1) week suspension and may not be present at any KSC sanctioned activity, including but not limited to games, practices, practice games, tournaments, or friendly games, during such period. The failure to comply with the discipline imposed shall be sufficient cause for the D&P Committee to discipline the player related to the spectator, parent, fan or supporter; the team which the spectator, parent, or fan supports; and/or the coach of such team.**
- **Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at game sites.**
- **Verified reports of assault not involving a referee and acts of misconduct beyond game dismissal or ejection committed by spectators, coaches and players shall be subject to additional suspensions in accordance with the D&P Sanctioning Guidelines.**
- **“ZERO TOLERANCE” POLICY FOR SIDELINE MISCONDUCT WILL BE ENFORCED. THIS INCLUDES INAPPROPRIATE LANGUAGE, RACIAL SLURS, OR VERBAL ABUSE TOWARD REFEREES, PLAYERS & GAME OFFICIALS BOTH ON AND OFF THE PLAYING FIELD. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their team and supporters.**
- **Our organization takes great pride in its reputation for open, honest, and fair dealings at every level. Compliance with the rules and regulations of the organizations with which we are affiliated is both necessary and desirable to protect the integrity of the Club, our membership and the game.**

PRACTICE FIELD ASSIGNMENT

As the Head Coach - it is YOUR responsibility to select/reserve a day/time for practice. You will select any day, Monday-Thursday (5:00pm-8:00pm). All practice takes place at Meyer Park - north side.

PLEASE NOTE: The coaches who attend the preseason Coaches' Meeting will get their first pick at practice fields; therefore, it is highly recommend that you (and/or your assistant coach/team representative) attend.

If you are unable to attend the meeting, please contact Eric Juarez, the Director of Coaching, to sign-up for your practice slot (kleinsoccercoaches@gmail.com). In the email you MUST include your age group, team gender (if U8 or older) and preferred practice day/time. We will not consider and/or reply to any practice requests until after the Coaches' Meeting. Please expect a reply no later than 24 hours after the meeting so you can prepare accordingly.

We will do our best to accommodate your practice day/time request, but keep in mind that sign-up is on a first come/first serve basis.

We allow teams two weeks to select their first practice slot prior to allowing teams to request an additional practice slot.

FIELD AND WEATHER ALERT INFORMATION

Everyone should be aware of the potential dangers posed by different weather conditions and work together to keep the players and other participants as safe as possible.

Hot Weather:

Heat becomes a problem when it prevents the body from cooling itself. The hotter the body gets, the more likely it is to increase fatigue levels, develop cramps and increase the possibility of heat exhaustion and heat stroke. The hotter and more humid the weather, the faster these problems can develop. Temperatures as low as 65 degrees, with a relative humidity of 100%, can be serious.

Cold Weather:

Like heat, cold weather can become a player safety factor. Field conditions will be affected by freezing rain, sleet and snow. The ground may become frozen and unsafe for play.

For practice sessions, coaches are responsible for monitoring the heat index and current radar, as well as taking the appropriate precautions to ensure player safety, which includes:

- Ensuring hydration breaks during practice, plus mandatory breaks every 20 minutes (when applicable)
- Adjust or shorten practice sessions
- Cancelling/reschedule practice



FIELD AND WEATHER ALERT INFORMATION

For scheduled games, KSC Administrators and Lead Referee Coordinators are responsible for monitoring the heat and cold index and the current radar (by weather radio, online with Perry Weather System, or the Weather Channel), and keeping the participating teams and game officials informed of the heat/cold index and weather conditions.

Referees on site will also monitor the weather conditions.

Any temperature at dangerous heat would shorten games, and any temperature at freezing or below (including any inclement weather) would delay games until weather conditions are above freezing and/or when inclement weather subsides.

If there is lightning within 10 miles all play is suspended; 30 minute delays between each lightning strike will be enforced.

If the game is in the second half when a lighting delay (or inclement weather) occurs the game is ended.

Called games are not likely to be rescheduled.

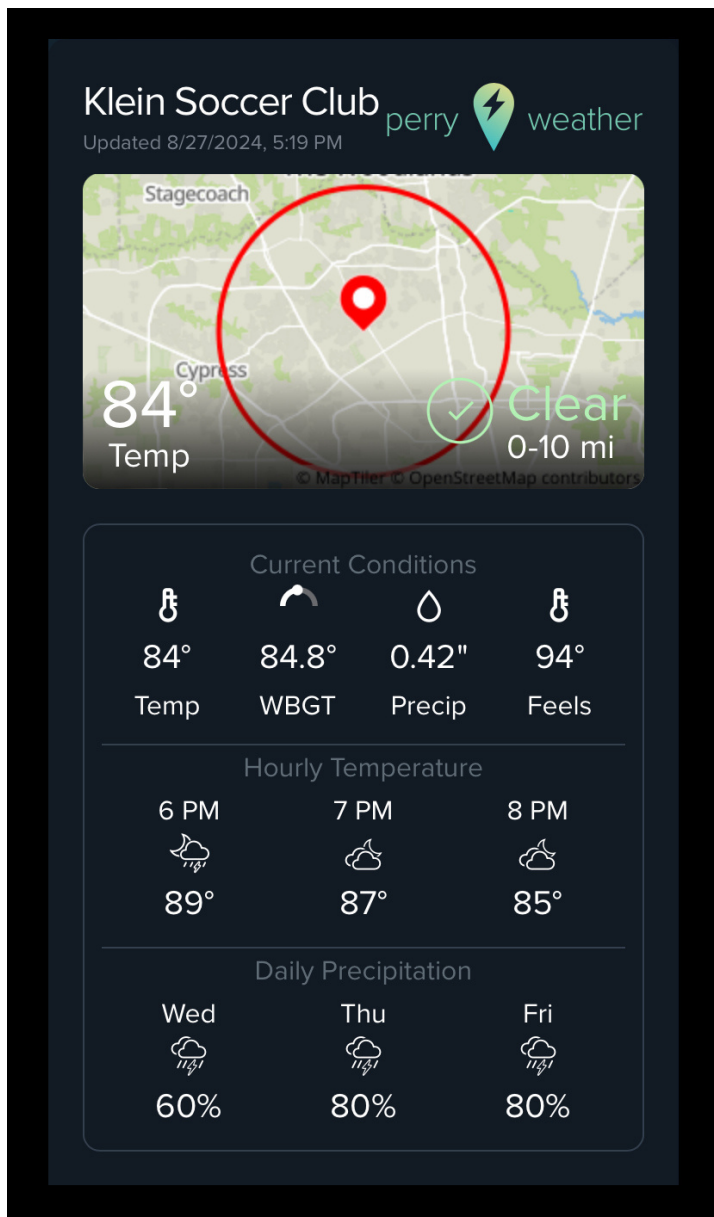

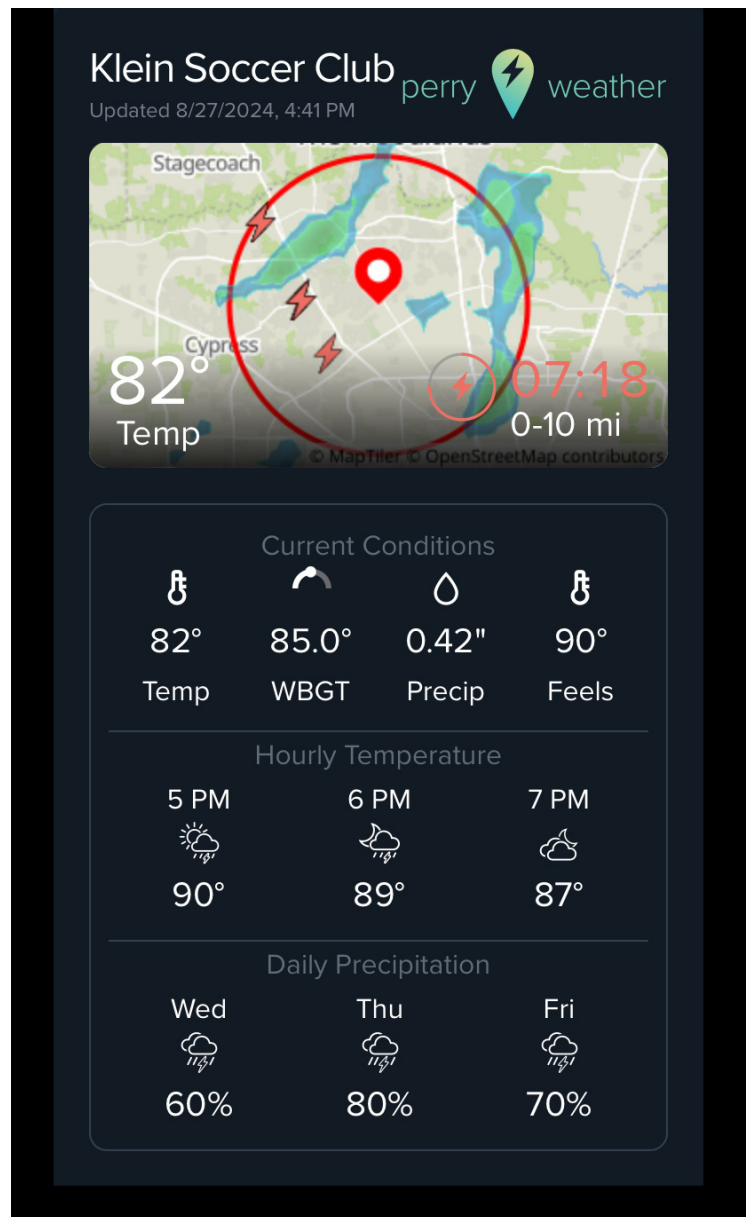

INCLEMENT WEATHER PROTOCOL

The following guidelines will be used by KSC when there is a possibility of a dangerous heat index:

HEAT INDEX	MATCH PLAY GUIDELINES
Up to 89°	Normal Play
90° - 99°	Implements a mandatory two-minute water break per half with running time.
100° - 105°	Implements a mandatory two-minute water break per half with running time. Each half may be shortened by five minutes.
106° - 108°	Implements two mandatory five-minute water breaks per half with running time.
109°+	Suspend Play

The following guidelines will be us by KSC when there is a possibility of cold weather:

COLD INDEX	MATCH PLAY GUIDELINES
46° and higher	Normal Play
36° - 45°	Allow additional clothing as detailed on page 9 of the handbook.
30° - 35°	Shorten games by 5 minutes per half. Allow additional clothing as detailed on page 9 of the handbook.
29° and lower	Suspend Play

Temperature is defined as the heat/wind chill index or the ambient temperature. Field closures/game schedule adjustments are dependent on the higher/lower of the two temperatures.
