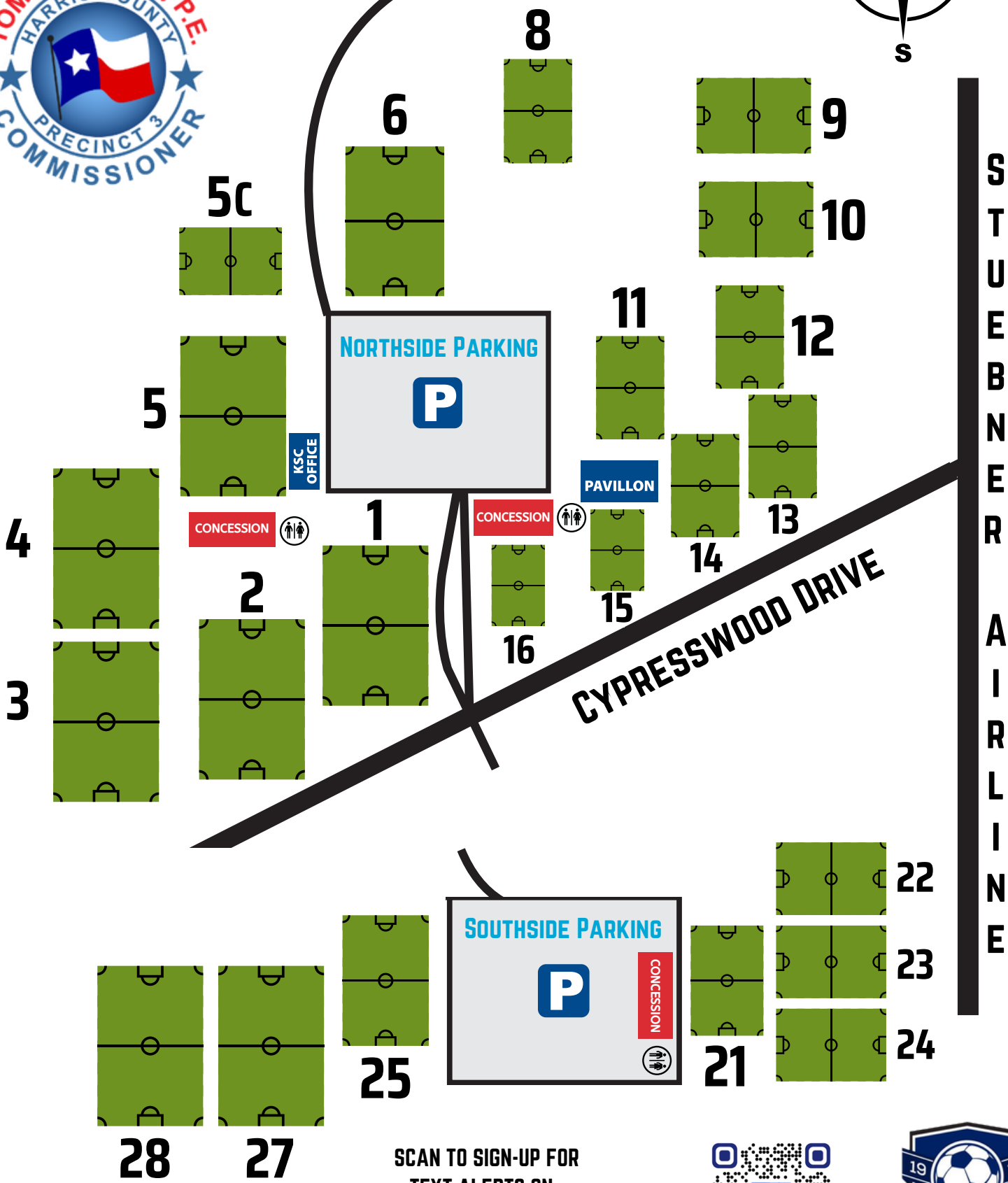
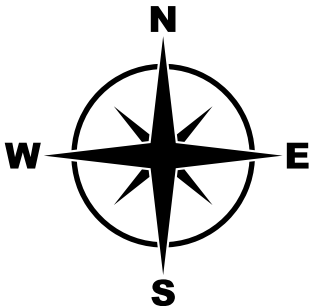

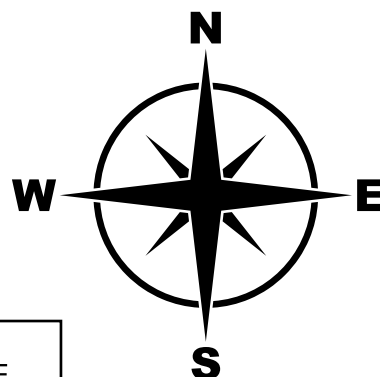


FALL 2026: FIELD MAP

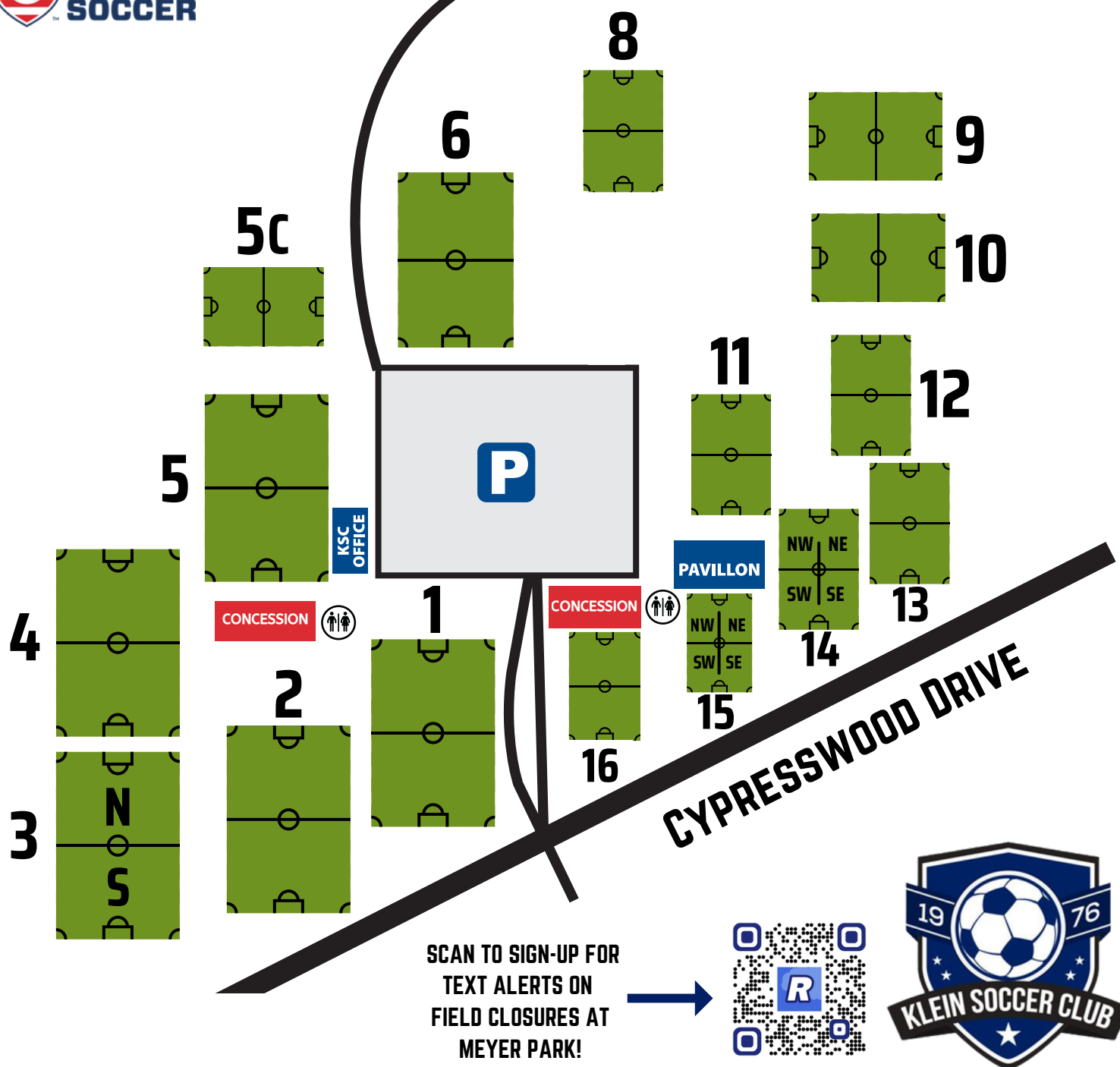

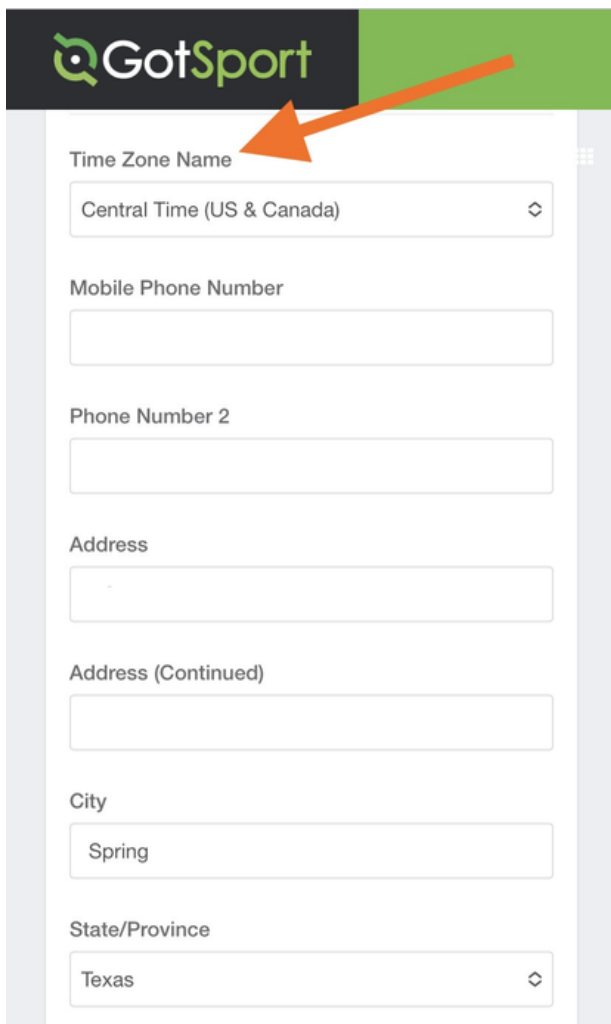

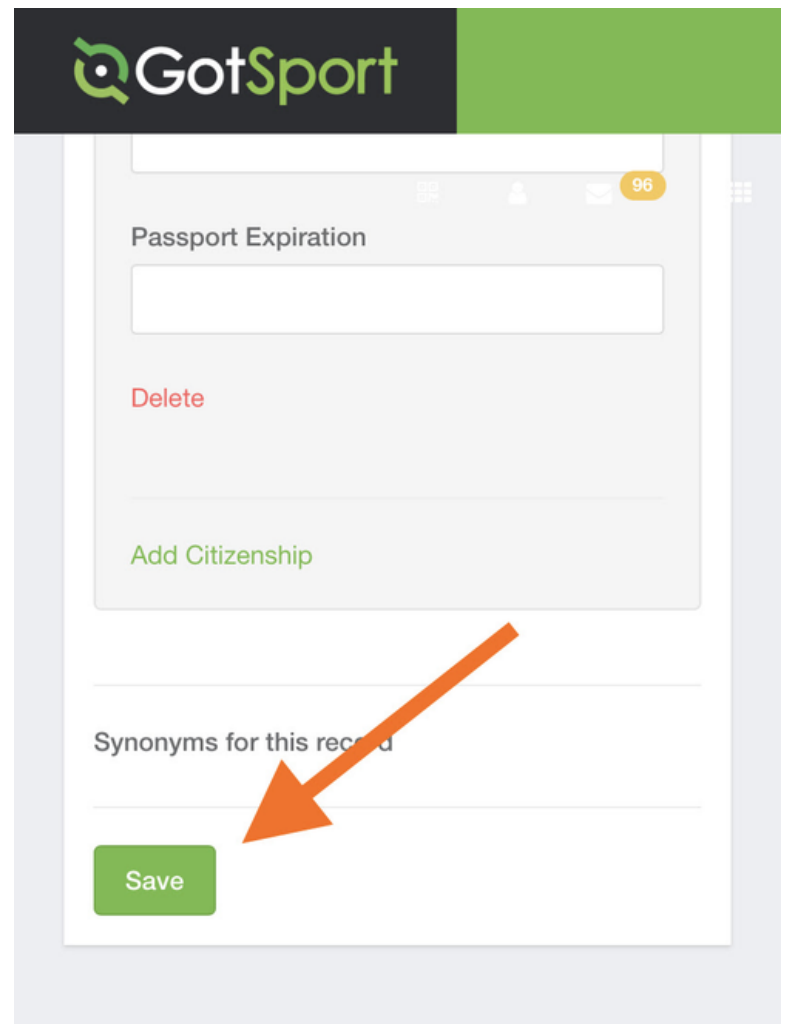

PRACTICES/GAMES:

It is the coach's responsibility to select a day/time for practice (Monday-Thursday). All practice takes place at Meyer Park - north side. The coach will communicate with you about your practice details.

All recreational games are played on Saturdays at Meyer Park, beginning: Saturday, September 12th.

The game schedule will be released no later than one week before the first weekend of games.

As the parent/guardian - please ensure your child arrives on time to practice/game, and that you communicate with the coach if your child will miss.

Also, be sure to make sure your child is prepared and dressed accordingly. Please have your child wear shin guards, soccer cleats, socks, and comfortable athletic attire.

Be sure that your child brings a ball and water bottle as well.

Please have your child dress appropriately - add layers or wear and beanie/gloves if it is cold; consider bringing a cooling towel or sports drink if the weather is hot.

We also recommend applying sunscreen or bug spray (as a precaution / if applicable).



UNIFORM:

- **ALL players are required to purchase the Official Klein Soccer Club 2026/2027 Uniform Kit* (*no exceptions).**
- **Uniform kits are not included in registration cost and are purchased separately for \$66 (plus tax) online: <https://achallenge.com/clubs/klein-soccer-club/>. After purchasing - the uniform will usually ship within 3-5 business days.**
- **We recommend double checking the size chart to make sure the proper size is ordered. We have samples at the office if you would like to check your size before ordering. Visit us during posted office hours.**
- **Uniform kits include a reversible jersey, shorts, and socks.**
- **The uniform is used for Fall 2026 and Spring 2027.**
- **The uniform is a light weight, breathable fabric (100% polyester). Due to reversibility, logos printed on either side may be visible when worn either way.**
- **No alterations to the uniform are allowed (i.e., added images, numbers, names or logos. Such items are only permitted with KSC Board approval).**
- **Uniforms must be purchased NO LATER than the second weekend of scheduled games. Failure to have the uniform, and your child will be subject to not be allowed to play.**
- **See the next few pages for additional uniform information.**

PLAYER CLOTHING PROTOCOL:

Additional Clothing:

Players should be allowed to dress in appropriate clothing to accommodate colder temperatures.

Please note the following on what is allowed:

- **Long sleeve shirt, sweatshirt, jacket (must be worn under jersey so referee can see number).**
- **Long pants, tights, leggings, sweatpants.**
- **Gloves or mittens**
- **Stocking caps without straps**
- **Headbands**
- **Additional socks (under uniform socks)**

The following items present a safety hazard and should NOT be allowed to be worn during practice or games:

- **Hooded sweatshirts and hooded jackets**
- **Earmuffs or scarves**
- **Earrings or jewelry**

KSC COMMUNITY CODE OF CONDUCT

- **Players, coaches/team managers/admins, and spectators are expected to conduct themselves within the spirit AND the letter of the LAW. Displays of temper or dissent are cause for ejection from the game and surrounding field area. A misconduct report will be reported to STYSA and/or the team's state association. Coaches/team managers are responsible for the conduct of their team and supporters both on and off the fields.**
- **U9+ GAMES ONLY:**
 - **Yellow Cards:** A player or coach receiving two yellow cards during a match is suspended from that match and shall be suspended from the next match. In the event this occurs, players and coaches must follow the instructions as outlined in the next paragraph.
 - **Red Card/Ejection:** A player or coach/team manager receiving a red card/ejection is suspended from the match and shall be suspended from the next match. Players or coaches receiving a red card/ejection must leave the match immediately and report to the Klein Soccer Club office. The ejected player or coach must complete a game ejection form and turn in the completed form to the staff member at the office. Players may sit on the bench during their suspension; however they shall not be in uniform. Coaches/team managers must not return to the game/tournament site during the match for which they are serving the one game suspension.
- **Uniforms are not allowed to be altered (i.e., added images or logos are only permitted with KSC Board approval).**
- **Parents, fans or supporters in attendance at a KSC game or hosted event subject themselves to the jurisdiction of the D&P Committee and the KSC Board, which shall include investigation and disciplinary action. Parents with grievances against their own coach or team should first work through 1) their coach and 2) the Director of Coaches to resolve any complaints before filing a grievance to the Club President (D&P Chairman).**

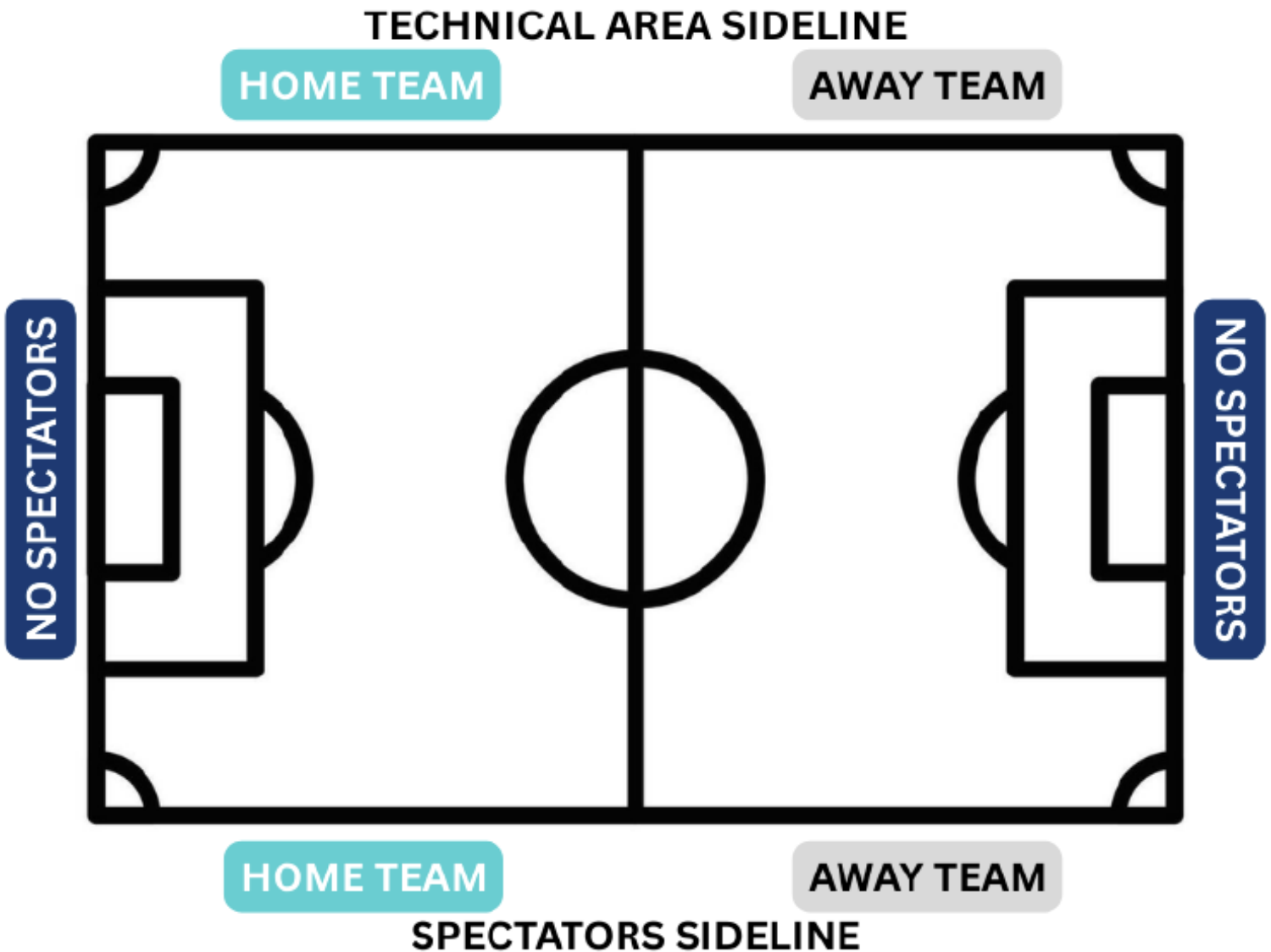


KSC COMMUNITY CODE OF CONDUCT

- **Parents and players must be on opposing sides of the field. Only Coaches/Team Managers/Admins with an up-to-date KidSafe Badge are permitted to be on the player sideline during a match.**
- **No parents, fans or supporters allowed behind the goals during a match.**
- **Spectators, parents, fans, or supporters of any KSC team who are sent away from the field of play by a referee or a competition official shall receive an immediate one (1) week suspension and may not be present at any KSC sanctioned activity, including but not limited to games, practices, practice games, tournaments, or friendly games, during such period. The failure to comply with the discipline imposed shall be sufficient cause for the D&P Committee to discipline the player related to the spectator, parent, fan or supporter; the team which the spectator, parent, or fan supports; and/or the coach of such team.**
- **Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at game sites.**
- **Verified reports of assault not involving a referee and acts of misconduct beyond game dismissal or ejection committed by spectators, coaches and players shall be subject to additional suspensions in accordance with the D&P Sanctioning Guidelines.**
- **“ZERO TOLERANCE” POLICY FOR SIDELINE MISCONDUCT WILL BE ENFORCED. THIS INCLUDES INAPPROPRIATE LANGUAGE, RACIAL SLURS, OR VERBAL ABUSE TOWARD REFEREES, PLAYERS & GAME OFFICIALS BOTH ON AND OFF THE PLAYING FIELD. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their team and supporters.**
- **Our organization takes great pride in its reputation for open, honest, and fair dealings at every level. Compliance with the rules and regulations of the organizations with which we are affiliated is both necessary and desirable to protect the integrity of the Club, our membership and the game.**
- **During the games, please be respectful to those around you. Anyone found to be verbally abusive to any player will no longer be permitted to spectate during games.**
- **All spectators are required to sit on the opposite side of the field during game days. This is not only a KSC policy but is also governed by the South Texas Soccer Association and US Youth Soccer. See the next page for a visual reference.**

FIELD AND WEATHER ALERT INFORMATION

Everyone should be aware of the potential dangers posed by different weather conditions and work together to keep the players and other participants as safe as possible.

Hot Weather:

Heat becomes a problem when it prevents the body from cooling itself. The hotter the body gets, the more likely it is to increase fatigue levels, develop cramps and increase the possibility of heat exhaustion and heat stroke. The hotter and more humid the weather, the faster these problems can develop. Temperatures as low as 65 degrees, with a relative humidity of 100%, can be serious.

Cold Weather:

Like heat, cold weather can become a player safety factor. Field conditions will be affected by freezing rain, sleet and snow. The ground may become frozen and unsafe for play.

For practice sessions, coaches are responsible for monitoring the heat index and current radar, as well as taking the appropriate precautions to ensure player safety, which includes:

- Ensuring hydration breaks during practice, plus mandatory breaks every 20 minutes (when applicable)
- Adjust or shorten practice sessions
- Cancelling/reschedule practice



FIELD AND WEATHER ALERT INFORMATION

For scheduled games, KSC Administrators and Lead Referee Coordinators are responsible for monitoring the heat and cold index and the current radar (by weather radio, online with Perry Weather System, or the Weather Channel), and keeping the participating teams and game officials informed of the heat/cold index and weather conditions.

Referees on site will also monitor the weather conditions.

Any temperature at dangerous heat would shorten games, and any temperature at freezing or below (including any inclement weather) would delay games until weather conditions are above freezing and/or when inclement weather subsides.

If there is lightning within 10 miles all play is suspended; 30 minute delays between each lightning strike will be enforced.

If the game is in the second half when a lighting delay (or inclement weather) occurs the game is ended.

Called games are not likely to be rescheduled.

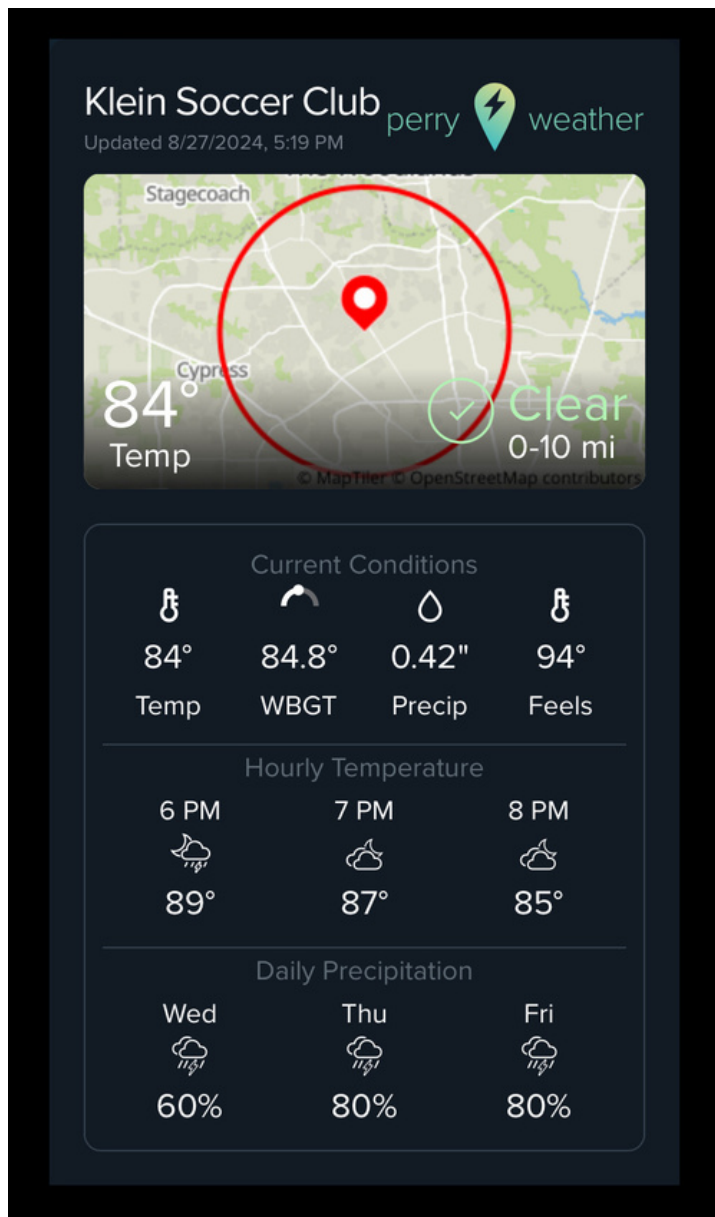

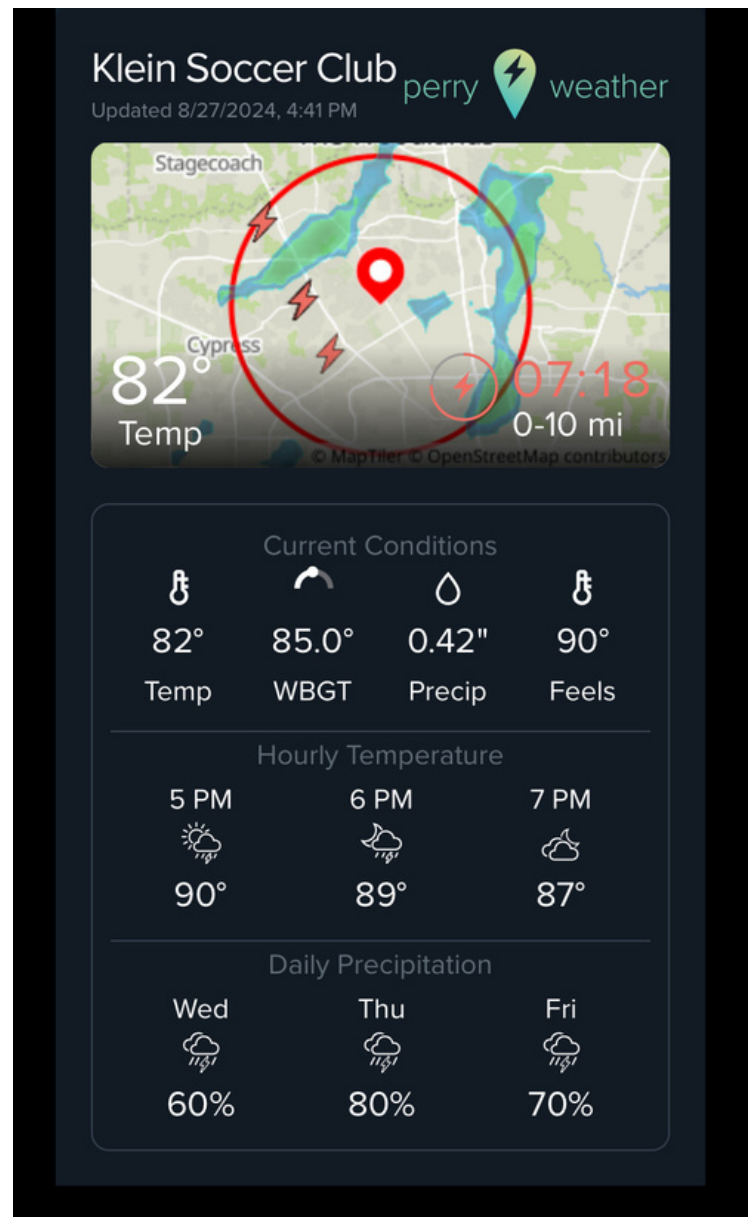

INCLEMENT WEATHER PROTOCOL

The following guidelines will be used by KSC when there is a possibility of a dangerous heat index:

HEAT INDEX	MATCH PLAY GUIDELINES
Up to 89°	Normal Play
90° - 99°	Implements a mandatory two-minute water break per half with running time.
100° - 105°	Implements a mandatory two-minute water break per half with running time. Each half may be shortened by five minutes.
106° - 108°	Implements two mandatory five-minute water breaks per half with running time.
109°+	Suspend Play

The following guidelines will be us by KSC when there is a possibility of cold weather:

COLD INDEX	MATCH PLAY GUIDELINES
46° and higher	Normal Play
36° - 45°	Allow additional clothing as detailed on page 11 of the handbook.
30° - 35°	Shorten games by 5 minutes per half. Allow additional clothing as detailed on page 11 of the handbook.
29° and lower	Suspend Play

Temperature is defined as the heat/wind chill index or the ambient temperature. Field closures/game schedule adjustments are dependent on the higher/lower of the two temperatures.

How do I register my child for Klein Soccer Club?

What play level and ages does Klein Soccer Club support?

- We are a Recreational League - ages U4-U16 boys and girls (3 years to 15 years old - born August 1st, 2010 to July 31st, 2023). Our program is a parent volunteer coached program and is an excellent introduction to soccer for kids. No previous soccer experience is required to register. The majority of our play level is recreational, and our focus is to build our player's knowledge of soccer in an enjoyable environment.

Where are practice and games held?

- Practice and Home Games for Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 are played at Meyer Park (located at: 7700 Cypresswood Drive / Spring, TX / 77379). U4-U16 play games on Saturdays at Meyer Park. Practice is one day per week - Monday to Thursday - after 5:00pm and as late as 6:30/7pm. You will find out your practice schedule after your child's coach attends the Coach's Meeting prior to the season starting. There are times when a coach practices two times a week - but this usually applies to U10-U16 teams only.

When does registration start for each season? When do seasons start each year?

- The fall season registration begins in June and the season runs from September until November. The spring season registration begins in October and the season runs from February until May.

How many weeks/games are played per season?

- Each season lasts for 10-weeks. The number of games depends on the number of teams in the age group and the weather. We always do our best to get every team ten games; however, if the age group does not have enough teams you will have a minimum of eight.

How are teams formed? Can I request to play with a friend or family member?

- Teams are formed based upon if your child is a returning player, as well as your child's level of soccer experience. You can request to play with the same coach, friend and/or family member during the online registration process. Per state regulations, your child can play up in an age group (by no more than two years - and with Board approval), but your child cannot play down in an age group.





KLEIN SOCCER CLUB - Q & A

(CONTINUED)

What day and time does my child practice? Can I request a certain day? What if I can't practice on the day the coach has selected?

- **At this time - we don't allow for a parent to select or specify a practice day because the coaches are volunteers and he/she selects their practice slot based on their schedule. The coach will not select their practice slot until they attend their meeting on Saturday, August 22nd. Practices begin the week of August 24th.**
- **What we can do: wait to see which teams your kiddos are assigned to - and more specifically, what day/time they will practice.**
- **Here are the scenarios:**
 - **Best case scenario - no change is needed.**
 - **Middle case scenario - we can check availability on other teams that practice on your requested days and move them to that team.**
 - **Worst case scenario - there's no availability to move (which is unlikely) - and we will provide you with a refund.**

How do I purchase my child's uniform? If my child played before do they need a new uniform? Can I buy the jersey only (and not the kit)?

- **Every Fall we get new uniforms; therefore, you are required to purchase a new kit. The uniform from Fall 2026 is used for Spring 2027. Uniform kits are not included in registration cost and are purchased separately for \$66 (plus tax) online: <https://achallenge.com/clubs/klein-soccer-club/>. Uniform kits include a reversible jersey, shorts, and socks. You are unable to buy the jersey only; you are required to purchase the entire kit. We recommend double checking the size chart to make sure the proper size is ordered. Only new players are required to purchase a uniform in the Spring season.**
