
If you are completing any trainings, it is recommended to access your account on a desktop and not a mobile device.



ALL coaches/team managers/admins are required to wear their KidSafe Badge on the sidelines at ALL times. No exceptions.

PROCEDURES AND POLICIES

- Make sure all players get at least 50% play time during games.
- Spectators and players/coaches must be on the opposite sides of the field for the game to begin. Anyone who does not have a kids safe pass and is registered as a coach must remain on the opposite side of the field as the players.
- No spectators or coaches allowed behind the goals during any games.
- Coaches are the voice for all of their players and parents. If there is any issues please communicate with your team and relay that information to the KSC board.
- Referees will not be perfect every single game. If you have any questions regarding rules or if you have an issue with a referees calls during a game please contact Chris Ellender the Vice President and Director of Referees. Everything will go much smoother if a coach contacts the KSC board to come access a referees performance and handle any issues, versus a referee calling the KSC board to remove a coach for harassing them during the game.
- The KSC board has many coaching tools available if you are unsure on how to run practices or what to do on game days.
- Coaches requesting a game reschedule are to contact the opposing coach and work out a mutually agreeable date and time with each other that does not conflict with other games scheduled.
- Coaches may contact/visit the office during hours, to obtain the opposing coach's contact information. OR, they can email the office staff to obtain the information office.ksctexas@gmail.com
- All reschedule requests are required to be emailed to the Director of Scheduling, Jessica Suber - kleinsoccerscheduling@gmail.com - no later than Monday night before the scheduled game. Both coaches must be included on the email.
- Games will NOT be rescheduled if both coaches have not agreed to the reschedule. If the opposing coach will not agree to the reschedule, the game will be played on the original date.

<u>Please Note</u>: You will be notified by the text alerts if cancellation due to weather occurs.

<u>IMPORTANT</u> - Please have the parents/guardians sign up for text alerts as this helps for practices too.

For practice sessions, coaches are responsible for monitoring the heat index and taking the appropriate precautions to ensure player safety, which includes:


- Ensuring hydration breaks during practice, plus mandatory breaks every 20 minutes.
- Adjust or shorten practice sessions
- Cancelling/reschedule practice

For scheduled games, KSC Administrators and Lead Referee Coordinators are responsible for monitoring the heat index (by weather radio, online or the Weather Channel) and keeping the participating teams and game officials informed of the heat index and weather conditions.

Referee coordinators on site will also monitor the weather conditions and make the decision to cancel a game or call it anytime after the start of the game. Called games are not likely to be rescheduled.

The following guidelines will be used by KSC when there is a possibility of a dangerous heat index:

HEAT INDEX	MATCH PLAY GUIDELINES
Up to 89°	Normal Play
90° - 99°	Mandatory two-minute water breaks per half with running time.
100°- 105°	Mandatory two-minute water breaks per half with running time. Each half may be shortened by 5 minutes.
105°+	Suspend Play
