

Tom Francesconi Ellison Bay Workshop Lodging

Below, I have provided a list of lodging options. The Parkside Inn (see picture), is across the street from the workshop location. Most of the remaining listings are located in Sister Bay which will require a longer daily commute. I recommend going to the individual sites for images and information.



The Parkside Inn, Ellison Bay. www.theparksideinn.com It is simple and clean. The Parkside is situated almost directly across the street from the workshop location. They offer a continental breakfast of coffee, pastries and fruit. There are no phones in the rooms.

Ellison Bay is located on the north end of the peninsula and is a little quieter and therefore lacks the amount of amenities found in most of the other villages. There are more choices for dining and groceries in Sister Bay, but would involve a 5 mile commute from the workshop location. The Blue Bear restaurant is in Ellison Bay and is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The Fireside Restaurant, also in Ellison Bay, offers wonderful meals. The Shoreline restaurant is 5 miles north of Ellison Bay in Gills Rock, and serves very good dinners along with a lovely water view.
