

Privacy Policy

The Dogwood Tales app and website are operated and presented to users in all locations by Apple App Store.

We are committed to providing an informative, entertaining, and safe app and website for Educators, Parents, Guardians and Children. We are dedicated to safeguarding any personal information collected on the Dogwood Tales website. We ensure that our Privacy Policy and our information practices adhere to applicable data privacy laws and all other applicable legislation.

To help ensure a rewarding online experience for our visitors, we provide you with this Privacy Policy that describes the information practices of the Dogwood Tales website (<https://getawayandcreate.com/dogwood-tales>) and the Dogwood Tales mobile application, including how we collect, use and disclose personal information.

The Information We Collect

We only see the abbreviated location and statistical information on the Apple platform, no personal information is collected from the app. The audio files are solely saved to the user's device and we have no access to these. That information is never shared to 3rd parties.

We may also request a user name and email address when a user submits a form through the "Contact Us" portion of the Dogwood Tales website so that we may respond to the inquiry. We collect the e-mail address for the sole purpose of responding directly on a one-time basis to a specific inquiry.

For some of our online activities on social platforms - such as polls, surveys, games or contests - we may ask users to provide information that is not personally identifiable, such as country of residence or a user's favourite colour. We also enable users to post online through a social platform group. If you use this function and disclose personally identifiable information, you should be aware that such information could be read, collected or used by other users. We strongly encourage you not to disclose personal information (such as real name, email address, telephone number, etc.) about the user or about any third party in such forums and are not responsible for the personally identifiable information you choose to submit through the post function. Finally, we may offer blogs or other Public Forums, as well as other features in which you may provide us with Submissions, but we take measures, including live moderation, so that users cannot communicate personal information through these Public Forums. If you use a Public Forum on this website, and disclose personally identifiable information, you should be aware that such information could be read, collected or used by other users. We are not responsible for the personally identifiable information you choose to submit in these Public Forums.

Additionally, we never collect 'cookie' data; however the host website Go-Daddy, Facebook and Apple do collect 'cookies'. Information on these can be found in their terms of service.

Cookies are small text files that are placed in visitors' computer browsers to store their preferences. You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn on/off all cookies. You do this through your browser (like Firefox or Internet Explorer) settings. Please note that most browsers are automatically set to accept cookies. Each browser is a little different, so look at your browser Help menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies. If you turn cookies off, you won't have access to many features that make your Web experience smoother, and some of our services may not function properly.

Finally, we don't collect any financial information. This is all handled by Apple and further information regarding financial information can be found in their Terms of service.

Collection of Information for Third-Party Sites and Sponsors

We do not allow third-party companies to solicit or advertise to our users. Our intention is to keep Dogwood Tales free from any of this sort of direct advertising.

Security

The security of your personal information is important to us and solely handled on the Apple platform. We handle as little non evasive information as possible.
