ARE YOU CONCERNED WITH YOU CHILD'S SPEECH, LANGUAGE AND/OR LITERACY SKILLS?

YOUR CHILD MAY QUALIFY FOR REBATES THRUGH THE CHRONIC DISEASE MANAGEMENT (CDM) PLAN.

PREVIOUSLY KNOWN AS ENHANCED PRIMARY CARE (EPC).

STEP 1: GP VISIT

- Your child may be eligible for Medicare rebates under the Chronic Disease Management (CDM) Plan.
- A GP assessment is required to determine eligibility.
- If eligible, the GP will prepare a CDM plan.

STEP 2: CDM PLAN

- Once you receive your CDM plan, it can be used for speech pathology visits.
- Your child can receive up to 5 rebated sessions each year.
- This covers individual sessions only (not group).

STEP 3: SPEECH VISIT

- Take your CDM plan to your speech pathologist (SP).
- The SP will support your child's communication needs.
- Payment is required upfront for each session there may be a gap.
- You can claim a \$60.35 Medicare rebate per session.
