PREFACE

With the silent and steady march of time Nimbark Math Seva Samiti Trust has recently completed 41 years of its Rural Service. The journey which was started 41 years back in a sleepy hamlet has now reached its present height and size after facing numerous storms and struggles, sunshine and shadow, triumphs and tragedy. Compared to the non-stop march of time of 41 years is but the blink of an eyelid; yet much actions and achievements have been packed into this short span.

Nestled in the backwards of Paschim Medinipur District, West Bengal, Nimbark Math Seva Samiti Trust, a Govt. registered. Non-Governmental, non-political, non-communal and non - profit making organization dedicated to social welfare and cultural activities. NMSST is registered - by the Govt. of West Bengal vide its Registration No. S0057425 of dated 13th day of January, 1988 under Societies Registration Act. 1961. The organization has been registered under FCRA vide its registration No. 147040155 dated 16/05/1991 under FCRA Act. Government of India 1976, authorizing the organization to receive the Foreign Grants directly. The organization has also been registered with Director of Exemption of Income Tax Deptt. For exemption u/s 12A, 80G of IT Act. 1962.

NMSST was established at Baikunthapur, a sleepy and slumberous hamlet in the remotest corner of Paschim Medinipur District, West Bengal in 1984. It is the epic of a great initiative. As we look back, an unbroken story on marvelous achievements unfolds before our vision and captivates our mind. We are taken aback as we think over that a noble heart, a responsive mind and dogged determination are capable of.

TARGET AREA

NMSST is at present working in West Bengal. In West Bengal the Society is mainly carrying out its activities in Paschim Medinipur, Purba Medinipur, Jhargram, Nadia, Bankura & Hooghly. To be more specific, the Society is working in Blocks of Daspur-I, Daspur-II, Ghatal, Chandrakona-I & Chandrakona – II. of Paschim Medinipur District.

TARGET GROUPS

Poorest of the poor in backward societies with a prime focus on women and children and persons with disabilities , older persons and Schedule Casts & Schedule Tribes, who are subjected to gross neglect of the society.

A BRIEF OUTLINE OF THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITION OF THE TARGET AREA

In West Bengal NMSST is mainly working in the backward hamlets of Paschim Medinipur, Purba Medinipur, Jhargram, Nadia, Bankura & Hooghly. The region reels under formidable illiteracy, wide-spread unemployment, colossal backwardness and economic stagnation. The bulk of the populations in this area live in extreme poverty and privation. The health-care system is totally in shambles in the areas. In particular, the condition of the women and children who have no access to improved health-care system is the worst.

Details of Activities

A. AWARENESS CAMPAIGN ON ENVIRONMENT POLLUTION :

To create an awareness amongst the villagers about the evil effects of environmental pollution. NMSST has launched massive awareness drive at the grass-root-level from its own sources. The villagers have mainly been encouraged to grow plants on organic process in massive scale and use smokeless chullahs as a guard against environmental pollution. Moreover, the villagers are encourage to avoid chemical fertilizers & pesticides during farming.

B. Special School For Visually Challenged Children

This programme aims to provide the educational and vocational education to visually challenged Children and their habilitation in the main stream. NMSST has started a Special School in the year 1991 and continuing till date. 230 students have pass out from this school. Presently, 36 students (Boys : 26 & Girls : 10) between the age of 5 to 14, are getting free schooling, fooding and lodging.

C. Old Age Home: - Nimbark Math Seva Samiti Trust offers shelter for older persons in the campus of Nimbark Math. NMSST provides free fooding with the fund support of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment. At present 25(16 men & 9 women) inmates are living in the campus. The facilities, the centre offered them, are Nutritional Care, Medical Treatment, Hygienic Care, Lodging and Recreational Care. Inmates are engaged in small activities like envelop making, fishing net weaving, basket making etc. These activities help them in double ways i.e, keeps them physically involved and economically independent. They enjoy outing program once a year.

D. Mobile Medical Dispensary: Nimbark Math Seva Samiti Trust is heaving only **One Ambulance Van**, which is use during day time till 4'o clock as mobile Van Dispensary that provides medical facilities for rural Scheduled Tribes in the Debra, Daspur-I & II, Salbani, Garahbeta -I & II Blocks through Mobile Medical Unit. The services offered them are medical facilities to the rural S. T. people and to encourage awareness regarding health care, nutrition and various Govt. facilities offered for development and making the better life style of the rural S. T. Till date ,12000 people have been benefited. Visually challenge The Mobile Medical Dispensary has been implemented by Nimbark Math Seva Samity Trust under the Aegis by Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India.

Purpose of the Organization:

A socio-economic, cultural & Philanthropic organization dedicated to numerous social welfare activities, especially for the downtrodden and economically challenged backward communities, having special emphasis on the depressed women in the field of health, education, motivation, child & mother care and skill development etc.

Present Animation of the Organization:

l) **Special School for Visually Challenged Children:** NMSST has started a Special School in the year 1991 and continuing till date. This programme aims to provide the educational and vocational education to Visually Challenged Children and their rehabilitation in the mainstream. 230 students have already passed out from this school. Presently, 36 students (Boys: 26 & Girls: 10) between the ages of 5 to 14, are getting free schooling, fooding and lodging.



m) **OldAgeHome:** NimbarMathSevaSamitiTrust offers shelter for older persons in the campus of Nimbar Math. NMSST provides free fooding, lodging and treatment with the fund support of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment. At present 25 (16 men & 9 women) inmates are living in the campus. The facilities, the centre offered them, are Nutritional Care, Medical Treatment, Hygienic



Care, Lodging and Recreational Care. Inmates are engaged in small activities like envelop making, fishing net weaving, basket making etc. These activities help them in double ways i.e., keeps them physically involved and economically in dependent. They enjoy outing program once a year.

n) Mobile Medical Van Dispensary: Nimbark Math Seva Samiti Trust is having only **One Ambulance Van**, which is use during the day time till 4'o clock as mobile Van Dispensary that provides medical facilities for rural Scheduled Tribes in the Debra, Daspur-I& II, Salbani, Garahbeta -I& II Blocks through Mobile Medical Unit. The services offered them are medical facilities to the rural ST people and to encourage awareness regarding health care, nutrition and various Govt. facilities offered for development and making the better life style of the rural ST till date 12000peoplehavebeenbenefited.TheMobileMedicalVan Dispensary services have been implemented by Nimbark Math Seva Samity Trust under the Aegis of Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India.



o) **Ambulance Van Service**: The same Ambulance Van is used after 4 pm for providing ambulance facilities for **Pregnant Women** and other **Critical Patients, upon phone calls in Emergency,** and are admitted to hospitals and after discharge there from, returned to their residences. A great number of such pregnant women and patients have been benefited. We are provide free Ambulance pariseva to needy people with help of SAIL, Balmer Lawrie and ONGC.



p) **Eye Care Centre**: One Eye Care Centre in the premises of the society where two Doctors check the patients in all the days in a week excepting Thursday and a nominal registration fee of Rs.50/- taken, for which free consultation and free medicines are also supplied.

q) **Vocational Training Centre: One**

Vocational Training Centre free of cost for needy/deserted educated unemployed ladies in embroidery and the course is for the period of 6 months for 6 women's in a group.



r) **Goshala:** One Goshala, where at present 32 nos. (25 female and 7 male including 1 Blind Cow), are there, wherefrom milk collected distributed amongst the poor tender children.



s) **Eye Camps:** Eye camps are conducted in the premises of the organization twice or thrice a month and a team of doctors check the patients & investigation, the cataract patients are forwarded to Vivekananda Mission Ashram Netra Niramay Niketan, Chaityanapur, Purba Medinipur for cataract operations and the rest patients, who do require Spectacles, are supplied free of cost.



t) **Yearly distribution of clothes, blankets etc.:** Thrice a year, Clothes, Blankets and Dresses are distributed to economically backward people including children. We are provide the cloth to 1000 (one thousand) people with kind help of Donor.



u) **Food distribution** :During natural calamities like flood, cyclone etc., dry food, including cooked food with

Drinking water supplied to the victimized families till they do return to their residences.

v) **Awareness Campaign on Environment Pollution:**

To create awareness amongst the villagers about the evil effects of environmental pollution, NMSST has launched massive awareness drive at the grass-root-level from its own sources. The villagers have mainly been encouraged to grow plants on organic process in massive scale and use smokeless chullahs as a guard against environmental pollution. Moreover, the villagers are encouraged to avoid chemical fertilizers & pesticides during farming.

L) **Free spectacle distribution camp** : We organized free spectacle distribution camp in the district of Paschim Medinipur, Purba Medinipur, Bankura & Hoogly and provide spectacle to rural needy people.


