

CODE OF CONDUCT

(7-16-23)

- Do not throw or slam golf clubs in anger.
- Do not cause destruction of any golf course property.
- Do not have any physical contact or verbal abuse with any competitor/opponent.
- No loud or profane language.
- For policing poor behavior, the AHMGC Rules Committee reserves the right to assess a two (2) stroke penalty to any member that breaches the "Code of Conduct". This penalty will be assessed on the day of the event before final posting of scoring or immediately after it is brought to the attention of the Rules Committee.
- For offenses deemed extreme by the Rules Committee, disqualification from the tournament may be warranted.
- On behavior deemed extremely severe a more appropriate penalty may be warranted than just disqualification from the tournament. These may include a suspension period from the AHMGC.
- If a member is assessed a disqualification or a more severe penalty by breaching the code of conduct, that member has the right to appeal at the next AHMGC board meeting. The disqualified/penalized member must notify the BOD President, Vice President or Rules Committee Chair that he intends to appeal the ruling 48 hours prior to meeting.
- The Rules Committee reserves the right to interpret the AHMGC Code of Conduct as appropriate.
