WOMEN'S WORLD MAJLIS

Advancing sustainable development

The Women's World Majlis is a key series in partnership with the World Majlis, as part of the larger Programme of People and Planet at Expo 2020 Dubai. Spanning six months, we will look into Expo Thematic Weeks topics through a gender lens by recognising and celebrating women from all over the world and their positive contributions in advancing sustainable development.



WOMEN IN ARABIA AND ISLAM

A historical and cultural perspective

Women in Arabia and Islam is a series held in partnership with the Louvre Abu Dhabi research programme and is inspired by the artworks of the museum, celebrating the rich Muslim heritage. Taking a historical and cultural perspective, the events focus on sharing and recognising the positive role women from Arab and Islamic backgrounds have played in the course of history until today.



OUTLIER'S SERIES

Outside of the thematic weeks

A series of panel discussions tackling issues not commonly part of the existing normative framework governing the agenda of gender equality and women's empowerment. Bringing together stakeholders from a wider range of sectors and geographic areas, participants will discuss critical topics and intersectional issues that fall outside of the thematic weeks of Expo 2020 Dubai.

Across six months, **the Cartier Outlier sessions engage the audience in action-oriented conversations on women's empowerment,** bringing together leaders from various countries and sectors in a collaborative effort to spark ideas and trigger change.

4-8 JANUARY 2022 - WOMEN, PEACE, AND SECURITY CONFERENCE

Expo 2020 Dubai co-curated with the UAE General Women's Union and UN Women

Twenty-one years after the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325 on Women, Peace, and Security (WPS), UN Women launched the **Compact on Women, Peace, and Security and Humanitarian Action** ("the Compact") as part of the Generation Equality Campaign celebrating the 25th anniversary of the Beijing Platform for Action.

As a board member of the Compact, the UAE has partnered with UN Women to bring the WPS agenda to a wider audience at Expo 2020 Dubai, and will provide a milestone for other board members and key stakeholders to measure progress against Compact goals. During Expo 2020 Dubai, **the Compact will announce achievements, and identify and agree on key deliverables.**



8 MARCH 2022 - INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

Expo 2020 Dubai co-curated with Cartier

The activities of the Women's Pavilion will culminate in a forum held on 8 March 2022, co-curated by Expo 2020 Dubai and Cartier under the theme "Creating New Perspectives". The event will present a **set of principles and commitments to promote positive attitudes and beliefs on women's rights and equality.**

With different activities throughout the day, Expo 2020 Dubai will highlight how the COVID-19 pandemic has exacerbated existing inequalities and will present steps to address them. **Expo will convene its family of partners, stakeholders, and visitors to highlight the importance of gender parity and new partnerships.**

The day of events will shine a light on women's leadership by tackling the issue of the harmful stereotypes and **negative social norms that still prevent women from reaching their potential in myriad sectors and industries.**

The forum will host leaders, public figures, gender advocates, and youth leaders who will deliberate on **the silent or invisible gender-based discrimination in professional settings,** with the aim of inspiring as many as possible to commit to adopting practices and policies dedicated to gender equality and women's leadership.
