Key Things to Remember

Top level soft skills like resourcefulness are built on other soft skills such as critical thinking, problem solving, decision making and creativity.

You need to understand what your resources are to be more resourceful.

Vocabulary (Examples of Soft Skills)

Creativity is the ability to demonstrate originality and inventiveness. In many industries, especially STEM professions, being creative and innovative are highly valued skills that can help you build a competitive advantage.

Critical Thinking is the ability to think logically to identify reasonable conclusions and effective solutions.

Decision Making is the thought process of selecting a logical choice from available options.

Problem-Solving is the process of finding solutions to difficult or complex issues. Almost every business is started with the intent of solving a problem and/or filling a need.

Resourcefulness is the ability to effectively find solutions to difficult situations and challenges.
