Vocabulary (Examples of Soft Skills)

Choice is the act of making a decision when faced with two or more possibilities.

Communication is the exchange of information between a sender and at least one receiver.

Control is the power to manage something especially one's own emotion or actions.

Decision is a conclusion or resolution after consideration of available options.

Helpfulness is the quality of giving or being ready to give help.

Judgement is the ability to make considered decisions or come to sensible conclusions.

Timing is the choice, judgement, or control of when something should be done.
