A YOUTH suicide crusader has demanded to meet with Prime Minister Julia Gillard to discuss the Territory's indigenous child crisis.

Balunu Foundation boss **David Cole** and **Aboriginal** elder Rex Granites, of Alice Springs, will head to Canberra today.

Mr Cole said his mission -- after Balunu was refused continued funding from the NT Government -- was to pitch the benefits of culture-based programs for ``at risk'' kids at a federal level.

``It is ludicrous that we are being overlooked,'' he said.

``Our approach for kids struggling with crime, suicide and identity crises is the only thing reaching them.''

Mr Cole said he contacted the Prime Minister's office on Monday.

``I told them we would be coming on Thursday or Friday,'' he said.
