

Public Hearing for 64ft Digital Billboard Affecting Westminster and Garden Grove Residents

Greetings Neighbors:

Have you heard of the proposed dual sided LED billboards that the city of Westminster is planning to install on the Rinks parking lot?

Electra Media Inc. is proposing to erect the advertising device at 13071 Springdale St., facing the Garden Grove (22) Freeway adjacent to the Westminster Rinks ice hockey facility.

The sign would be 64 feet above grade; the height maximum allowed now is 35 feet. *reported by orangecountytribune.com

Electra Media Inc. has one goal in mind and that's to generate revenue off of their investment. They don't care about how their billboard will affect you, your family or your property. I imagine you might feel the same way many of us do; like the 22 freeway is slowly turning into a miniature Las Vegas Strip with numerous obnoxious electronic billboards spewing spam advertisements onto our properties, parks and schools.
