



# Care Guide

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## 1. Dust Regularly

- Vacuum gently with a soft brush attachment (ideal for both blinds and curtains)
- Use a lint-free cloth or soft brush weekly to prevent dust buildup

## 2. Minimise Sun Damage

- UV rays can fade fabrics — close blinds or curtains during peak sunlight
- Choose blackout or thermal lining for extra protection
- Occasionally fully lower blinds to relax the folds

Tip - when furnishing a high sunlight area such as a conservatory, we recommend choosing fabrics with a uv protectant to ensure they don't fade

## 3. Avoid Harsh Spot Cleaning

- Blot any spills with a clean, dry cloth — never rub
- Avoid using water or commercial stain removers
- Always consult a professional cleaner for advice



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## 4. Professional Cleaning Only

- Most bespoke soft furnishings are dry clean only
- Inform cleaners that your item is hand-finished

## 5. Maintain Fold Structure

- Raise roman blinds slowly, guiding folds gently into place after each use
- Hand-dress curtains occasionally to keep pleats neat and consistent

## 6. Steam – Never Iron

- Use a handheld steamer to smooth creases
- Steam blinds while lowered and curtains while hanging and leave for at least 1 hour before moving back into place
- Always test a small hidden area first



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## 7. Inspect Hardware Occasionally

- Check chains, cords, and stitching periodically
- If you notice uneven folds or wear, contact us for advice
- All bespoke made furnishings are covered by a one year manufacturing warranty

### Bonus Tip Let Fabrics Breathe

Keep windows open regularly to avoid moisture build-up, especially in kitchens and bathrooms.
