(Please check each box to indicate item is true and/or has been completed)

Eligibility:

- The applicant must score at least eight hundred (800) on the SAT or at least fifteen (15) on the ACT, OR provide proof of planned enrollment in a technical or vocational program that does not require these scores
- The applicant must be
 1. An active member of the Texas FFA Association who is listed on the State Roster and is in good standing with the Texas FFA Association; **OR**
 2. An active member of the Texas 4-H Program and is in good standing; **OR**
 3. A Youth Volunteer at past Pleasanton Young Farmer Events.
- The applicant must be a current year graduating senior.

Submission:

- Submit all pages of the application
- Submit an official High School Transcript with school seal
- Submit a Letter of Recommendation from a High School Teacher or official.
- Scholarship Applications must be received by PYF via Email at pleasantonyoungfarmers@gmail.com by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, May 1st in order to be considered. No late applications will be considered.**
- Submit one (1) Colored Photograph of the applicant via email.

Other Information:

- Scholarship applications will be evaluated on a point system. There is a maximum of 100 points, based on GPA, FFA/4-H achievements, and involvement, PYF involvement, community participation, and completed forms.
- If awarded a scholarship, the scholarship will be available to the student for up to five months after graduation.
- If awarded a scholarship, proof of school registration is required to obtain scholarship funds. (Mail to: Pleasanton Young Farmers, PO Box 484, Pleasanton, TX 78064)
- If awarded a scholarship, the total scholarship amount will be paid in four equal payments of no more than \$500 over a two-year period from date awarded.
