ACCESSIBILITY TRAINING

- Ensure MTSS teams know all 13 disability categories.
- Train staff on supporting students with disabilities.
- Offer workshops for parents on rights, 504s/IEPs.
- Share books, resources, and presentations that explore difference.
- Encourage classroom/whole school conversations and resources celebrating differences

Empower parents as equal partners. A supportive school culture eases the extra effort adaptability requires, allowing students to thrive academically and socially.
