**GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:**

1. REQUIREMENTS: Riders MUST have current Equine Liability Insurance to enter the show and proof will be asked for. WSDAC Membership and WSDAC horse registration are required in order to submit to WSDAC after the shows.
2. HELMETS: Mandatory for ALL competitors and riders when mounted.
3. LOCATION: Kirkridge Farm, Lynden Ontario
4. SHOW RING: Outdoor Sand Arena. Introductory and Basic Level tests shall be held in the 20X40m ring. Level 1-4 shall be held in the 20x60 ring.
5. STABLING is not available for these shows. There is plenty of parking available.
6. ALL Entries may be subject to an administration/service fees as listed on the entry form and in this prize list.
7. ENTRY FEE POLICY: Changes/cancellations of entries are allowed up to the deadline date of entry. Entries shall be received within the opening and closing dates of each show. No exceptions please. Please note that after the deadline date of entry you will be responsible to remit payment for entries regardless of changes/cancellations made after the deadline date of entry. NO REFUND of entries will be given without a Medical/Veterinary Certificate (refunds will be less administration fees). For any changes/cancellations please reply back to the confirmation email (you will receive an email after entries are submitted) or send changes to mail to: [equineshowproductions@gmail.com](mailto:equineshowproductions@gmail.com). Another confirmation email will be sent with the changes. ESP has the right to add or substitute entries as warranted after the close date.
8. WAITING LIST: In the event that the show fills, there will be a waiting list. Entry slots that become available will be filled in order on the waiting list.

9. AWARDS: Ribbons to 6th in all Classes.
10. RULES: Western Style Dressage Association of Canada rules and tests are used at this competition. Both available at <http://westernstyledressage.ca>
11. RULES: Cadora classes will use tests at cadora.ca and using EC rules.
12. All pets must be leashed.
13. Please be respectful of the facility. If you or your horse makes a mess, please clean it up.
14. TIMES available on the Wednesday prior to show date on the website.
15. SHOW OFFICE: Shall be located close to the show ring.
16. ENTRIES to be submitted online via Compete Easy. Entries will be considered accepted when full payment has been received.
17. A food concession will be available.
18. All competitors must sign indemnity form at show prior to competing.

**ESP YEAR END AWARDS:**

To be eligible for ESP Live Year-End awards a horse/rider combination must compete at the same class Level and Division in a minimum of 3 ESP Live shows. Champion and Reserve Champion are determined by totaling the three highest percentages in three different shows to give the year-end high score.
