TESTS:

<u>US Dressage Federation (USDF) Tests:</u> **\$25 per test** Intro – Fourth Level

USDF Introductory and Training (ridden in small or standard ring - 20m x 40m or 20m x 60m) ***First to Fourth level tests must be ridden in standard ring – 20m x 60m* Tests may be found at <u>www.usdf.org</u> ...competitions...dressage tests...2023 tests

Six Divisions – can only choose one - PeeWee (under 12 years), Junior "A" (12 - 14 years), Junior "B" (15 – 18 years), Adult Amateur, and Senior Amateur (50+ years), Pro Division is determined by age at January 1st, 2024.

Western Dressage (WSDAC) Tests: \$25 per test Intro – Level 4

WSDAC Introductory -Level 4 (ridden in small ring or standard ring - 20m x 40m or 20m x 60m) WSDAC sanctioned for Virtual Shows Points Program #2024MBV01 Tests may be found at westernstyledressage.cashowing...tests

WSDAC members may use test scores towards National Virtual Show Program. WSDAC members must pay a \$10 per show levy per horse/rider combination for this program, <u>must review WSDAC rules and</u> <u>wear show attire</u>.

Six Divisions – can only choose one - PeeWee (under 12 years), Junior "A" (12 - 14 years), Junior "B" (15 – 18 years), Adult Amateur, and Senior Amateur (50+ years), Pro Division is determined by age at January 1st, 2024.

Canadian Pony Club (CPC) Tests: \$25 per test Entry, Starter, Pre-Training

To be ridden in small or standard ring - 20m x 40m or 20m x 60m Tests may be found at <u>www.canadianponyclub.org</u> ...(activities) dressage...dressage tests Three Divisions – can only choose one - PeeWee (under 12 years), Junior "A" (12 - 14 years), Junior "B" (15 – 18 years) <u>Must be current Pony Club member.</u> Division is determined by age at January 1st, 2024.

<u>USDF Quadrille Tests:</u> \$25 per test

Introductory, Training & First Level tests, all to be ridden in 20m x 60m ring May use English and/or Western tack Test to be found at <u>www.usdf.org</u> Classes for 2 horses or 4 horses Three divisions – Adults Only, Adult/Junior Combos, Juniors Only

Each horse/rider combination must pay a \$12 office fee. Office fee is only paid once, can cross enter USDF, WSDAC, CPC & Quadrille.

General Information:

- 1. **Helmets are mandatory.** Must wear boots with a heel. Show attire is not required except for WSDAC member tests.
- 2. <u>Strip ribbons</u> will be awarded to 6th place.
- 3. Entries to be submitted via email. Payment by e-transfer. Entry will be considered complete and tests assigned to judge only after completed entry form and payment received.
- 4. All tests may be called. Scored tests will be sent to your email address.
- 5. No horse/pony shall be ridden in more than 4 tests in one day.

Video Information:

Videos can be filmed at any time, they need to be sent in to the show office between May28 - June 4. Please remember class information sign at the beginning and tack check at the end of the video.

- 1. Videos must be uploaded to your own YouTube account then link sent to show secretary, only one video per test; video may only be used for this show.
- 2. Use competition rings that are as near as possible to regulation size and be sure letters are set appropriately to be viewed by the judge.
- 3. Tests must be videoed from C in the horizonal landscape orientation.
- 4. Videos of tests must be **UNEDITED** from start to finish. They must be **one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times.** Make sure test ring letters are in the frame, may zoom in slightly in the far corners, pay close attention to near corners.
- 5. **Sound must be on**, natural background noise audible. Tests may be called.
- 6. Prior to test ride beginning a **class information sign** must be held up showing the name of the show, the date of the show, the horse's name, rider's name and test being ridden
- 7. **No tack check for Quadrille tests**...for all other rides at the end of the test do a **tack check**, either the camera must slowly circle the horse & rider or the rider may show one side of horse (5 sec), slowly turn to show second side (5 sec).
- **8.** At the end of tack check, dismount, drop the bit and display for the judge (close up). This may be done by a helper if preferred however **make sure rider is dismounted first!**

<u> HiPoint Championships – USDF, WSDAC & CPC Tests, Amateurs & Juniors</u>

<u>HiPoint ribbons and prizes</u> will be awarded to one Peewee/Junior and one Adult/Senior Amateur in both USDF and WSDAC test groups.

A HiPoint ribbon and prize will be awarded to one Peewee/Junior in the CPC test group.

The **two highest test scores** at any <u>one level</u> will be added together, highest total in age group wins.

HiPoint Championship Senior Horse/Pony

Open to all horses/ponies 16+ years old in USDF, WSDAC and CPC tests. The **two highest test scores** (any riders or levels) will be added together, highest total wins.
